

Master Trainers' Training on water campaign for the states of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and J&K



The Master Trainers' Training Programme on NABARD Water Campaign was held on 19th and 20th April 2017 at NABARD Punjab Regional Office, Chandigarh. A total of 27 participants, including the nodal officers from the states of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir took part in the training. The training was conducted by Centre for Environmental Education (CEE), Ahmedabad.

Shri Deepak Kumar, Chief General Manager, Himachal Pradesh stated, while addressing the participants, that water conservation should be done in a mission mode and with dedication as this was a national priority.

CEE gave inputs on how the programme is to be run from District level (where Master trainers will train village level functionaries called Krishi Jal Dhoots) and who would then take the message to the village level. CEE also explained how the data is to be captured by KJD App under the programme.
