

NOTICE INVITING TENDERS

Invitation to bid for the supply, installation, commissioning and maintenance of Closed Circuit Television System at NABARD Head Office at Bandra-Kurla Complex, Mumbai-51

1. On behalf of National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), we have the pleasure of inviting you to tender for the aforesaid work.
2. **Eligibility Criteria**
 - a)The Bidder shall be a profitable registered company involved in the supply,installation,commissioning and maintenance of CCTV systems
 - b)The Bidder must have after sales and services facility in Mumbai
 - c)The Bidder must have executed a similar works in a Public sector undertaking/Central Govt. Department/Organisation/Public sector Banks of not less than 8 lakhs and 2 works of value not less than 3 lakhs during the preceding 3 years.
 - d)The Bidder must either be the Original Equipment manufacturer or an authorised dealer,.for supply and maintenance of CCTV systems

3.Bidding Process

The bidding will be a two stage bidding process and each bidder will submit two envelopes as indicated below:

1.Envelope 1 -- Technical Bid

This envelope must contain the following :

- a)Proof pertaining to the eligibility of the Bidder ie.copies of the income tax returns for the preceding three yeras(ie for the years 2007-08,2006-07 and 2005-06),copies of the work order and work completion certificates in respect of similar work executed in Public sector undertaking/Central Govt.Department/Organisations/Public sector Banks of value as indicated in the eligibility criteria, Copy of the registration of the firm/company and copy of the dealership certificate from the Original equipment manufacturer.
- b) Bidder' General Information(Annexure A)
- c) Compliance with Technical Specifications of System Equipment's,
- d) Details of Service / Support Infrastructure;

- e) Acceptance of all Terms & Conditions as mentioned in the NIT
- f) Product Brochures containing detailed description of essential technical and performance characteristics of offered equipment's;
- h) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account documents for the last 3 Financial years (2005-06,2006-07,2007-08);
- i) Undertaking to provide comprehensive One year On-site Warranty including free replacement of DVR system;
- k) Earnest Money Deposit by way of Demand Draft for an amount of Rs 20000/(Rupees twenty thousand only)

Envelope 2 -- Financial Bid

This envelope will contain the the Bill of Quantities duly priced.

4. Sealed Tenders in the prescribed tender form in two separate envelopes super scribed "Envelope No.1" and "Envelope No.2" should be submitted to the Chief General Manager, General Administration Department, National bank for Agriculture and Rural Development C-24, G Block, Bandra-Kurla complex, Bandra(East), Mumbai -400051.
5. The Envelope No.2 shall not include any conditions whatsoever. In case any conditions are included in Envelope No. 2 , the same shall not be taken into consideration and the tender in such case is liable to be rejected.
6. Both the envelopes shall be submitted to the above Office not later than **1500 hrs on 22 May 2009** .Envelope No.1 will; be opened at 1600 hrs on the same day in the presence of the tenderers or their authorised representatives who chose to be present..Based on the evaluation of the contents of envelope No.1,the Bank will decide opening of price bid in due course.
7. The Envelope No.2 shall be opened only in respect of those bidders who comply with all tender conditions put forth by the Bank and which are in line with requirements of tender document and are acceptable to the Bank.The decision of the Bank in this regard shall be binding on the bidders and not open to question or appeals.The date and time of opening of Envelope No.2 shall be intimated to the short listed parties by fax,e-mail and also by way of registered letter.
8. Tenders received late on account of any reason whatsoever and telephonic and faxed tenders shall not be entertained.
9. The completion of the said work shall be 45 days from the issue of the work order.
10. Liquidated damages for delay shall be 0.25% of the accepted tender amount per week of delay for each week beyond the scheduled date of completion or approved extended period of completion. The maximum amount of liquidated damages shall be 5% of the accepted tender amount.
11. The Defect Liability period shall be 12 months from the date of handing over the system to the Bank.

12. Validity of the tender shall be 60 days from the opening of Envelope No.2

13. Further Orders: The Bank may place further orders for supply, and maintenance of CCTV systems at the same rate and terms & per the Rate Contract entered into with finally selected vendor, within period of one year from the date of first purchase order. However, if during this period, there is any any downward price-revision for any of equipment's then vendor must offer the same to the Bank without any delay.

14 Indemnity: Vendor shall indemnify, protect and save the Bank against all claims, losses, costs, damages, expenses, action suits and other proceedings, resulting from infringement of any patent, trademark, copyright etc. or such other statutory infringements in respect of all the network equipment's supplied by it.

15. Resolution of Disputes: The Bank and the vendor shall make every effort to resolve amicably, by direct informal negotiation, any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the contract. If after thirty days from the commencement of such informal negotiations, the Bank and the Vendor are unable to resolve amicably a contract dispute; either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution by formal arbitration. All questions, disputes or differences arising under and out of, or in connection with the contract, shall be referred to two Arbitrators: one Arbitrator to be nominated by the Bank and the other to be nominated by the Vendor. In the case of the said Arbitrators not agreeing, then the matter will be referred to an umpire to be appointed by the Arbitrators in writing before proceeding with the reference. The award of the Arbitrators and in the event of their not agreeing, the award of the Umpire appointed by them shall be final and binding on the parties. The Arbitration and Reconciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the arbitration proceedings and the venue & jurisdiction of the arbitration shall be Mumbai.

15. A pre-bid meeting shall be held on 11 May 2009 at 1430 hrs in the conference hall of NABARD head office at the address indicated above. The bidders are requested to attend the meeting and obtain clarifications, if any, required by them. No further requests for clarifications shall be entertained.

General Conditions/Instructions to the Contractors.

1. Sealed Tenders, should be addressed to The Chief General Manager, General Administration Department, National Bank For Agriculture and Rural Development C-24, 'G' Block, Bandra-Kurla Complex, P.B. No.8121, Bandra (East), Mumbai - 400 051 and super scribed "Tender for the Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Maintenance of CCTV System" at Bandra-Kurla Complex for the "National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development" and send so as to reach him not later than 3 p.m on 22 May 2009
2. No tender will be received after 3.00 p.m. On 22 May 2009 under any circumstances whatsoever.
3.
 - a. Tenders will be opened at 4.00 p.m. On 22 May 2009 at his office by Chief General Manager, General Administration Department, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development, or any other officer designated for this purpose by him in the presence of other officials of the Bank and the tenderers or their representatives, should they choose to be present.
 - b. Tender shall remain open for acceptance by the Bank for a period of Two Months from the date of opening the tender which may be extended by mutual agreement and the tenderers shall not cancel or withdraw the tender during this period/extended period.
4.
 - a. The tender forms should be filled in English and all entries must be made by hand and written in ink.
 - b. Rate should be quoted both in figures and words in the columns specified. All erasures and alterations made while filling the tender must be attested by initials of the tenderers. Over writing of figures is not permitted, failure to comply with either of these conditions will render the tender void at the Bank's option. No advice of any change in rate or conditions after opening of the tender will be entertained.
 - c. Each of the tender documents should be signed by the person or persons submitting the tender in token of his/their having acquainted himself/themeselves with the General Conditions of

the Contract, Scope of work, Specifications, Special Conditions, etc., as laid down. Any tender with any documents not so signed is liable to be rejected.

- d. The tenders submitted on behalf of the Firm shall be signed by all the partners of the Firm or by a partner who has the necessary authority on behalf of the firm to enter into the proposed contract Similarly in case of a company, only the person authorised by the articles of the company can sign. Otherwise the tender is liable to be rejected by the Bank.
5. The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to itself the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders, without assigning any reasons for doing so.
 6. Contractors are advised to visit the site of installation of the CCTV System and understand the nature & scope of the work and doubts of any nature should be got clarified before quoting.
 7. Rate should include charges for removal of debris out of premises, removing stains, cleaning the site thoroughly and restoring it to original condition where work is undertaken.
 8. Quoted rate should be workable and should include all overheads and profits.
 9. Rate should include all taxes, duties, octroi, levies, Payment of wages as per Act , VAT etc.. and should be firm for the entire contract period. No variation of rates will be allowed.
 10. All components of the CCTV System supplied should confirm to the stipulations as in the relevant I.S. codes (Latest Edition) BIS specification shall be followed as applicable and should be UL certified. However, in the absence of the same the decision of NABARD will be final.
 11. The tender is being called as an item rate tender to be quoted against the Bill of Quantity. However, all other materials as may be necessary for the satisfactory work completion are to be provided at no additional cost as deemed to have been covered under the scope of work/contract. All civil, electrical, carpentry work will be done by the contractor and this cost also to be included in the amount quoted.
 12. Maximum 50 % of amount may be settled on delivery of items and the balance amount less the retention money and the amount quoted for AMC will be settled on commissioning of this system. No advance payment will be made by the Bank.
 13. Any discrepancy in settlement of bills may be brought to the notice of the Bank within a period of one month after the settlement of the Bills. The Bank will not entertain any claim regarding any dispute in settlement of the bills after the stipulated period.
 14. Income Tax, Surcharge, Service Tax, VAT and other taxes as applicable will be deducted from total payment due to the contractors.
 15. The contractor should have valid electrical contractors license relating to his contract. The contractor must submit a certificate from the manufacturers that the contractor is an authorized dealer for the sales and service of the products used in the CCTV System.
 16. The Contractor shall observe all the safety precautions for the safety of the labour and the employees of the Bank during execution of works. The contractor should arrange to obtain necessary insurance cover for its employees. He would be responsible for the safety of persons, employed by him.

17. The contractor shall be responsible for injury to persons or things and for damages to the property which may arise from omission or neglect of the contractor or their employees, whether such injury or damages arises from carelessness, accident or any other cause whatsoever, in anyway connected with carrying out of the work.
18. All the conditions of the contract shall be binding on the Contractor.
19. The Contractor shall comply with all the applicable Acts, Rules, Regulations, requirement of Law (s) for entering into contract and the Bank will not in any way be liable or responsible for any default/irregularities/penalties on the contractors part.
20. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of Contract, Labour Regulation & Abolition Act, 1970, Minimum Wages Act and all other labour laws and other Statutory Regulations (both Central and States) that may be enforced from time to time by the appropriate authorities. The Bank shall not be held responsible for any penalty on account of failure to adhere to the above labour regulations, etc. The contractor should be responsible to fulfill all the obligations in connection with the workers employed by the contractor for the purpose of the contract and all the Statutory and other liabilities if any including minimum wages, leave salary, uniform, ex-gratia, gratuity, ESI, Provident Fund, Workman Compensation, if any, etc.. in connection therewith shall be on the contractor account and payable by the concerned contractor.
21. The contractor should obtain necessary permission that may be required for the purpose of this contract from such authorities as may be prescribed by law from time to time.
22. The contractor shall be fully responsible and shall compensate the Bank in the event of any damage to men or material, injury/damage or death as the case may be, caused directly or indirectly due to the negligence of the contractor or his agents and / or his employees or workmen. The decision of the Bank in this regard shall be final and binding.
23. The contractor should not employ any person who is prohibited by law from being employed for fulfilling obligations under this contract.
24. Any act of indiscipline / misconduct/ theft/ pilferage on the part of any employee engaged by the contractor resulting in any loss to the bank in kind or cash will be viewed seriously and the Bank will have the right to levy damages or fine and / or even terminate the contract forthwith.
25. In case of any default or failure on your part to comply with all/ any one of the terms/ conditions, the bank reserves to itself the right to take necessary steps to remedy the situation including, inter-alia, the deduction of appropriate amount/ s from dues otherwise payable to you and/or by taking recourse to appropriate recovery proceedings.
26. The contractor should not at any time do, cause or permit any nuisance on the site/do anything which shall cause unnecessary disturbances or inconvenience to the occupants/visitors at site or near the site of work.
27. On site, lockable storage space will be given as per availability, the security of which will be the responsibility of the contractor's. The Bank will not be responsible for contractor's materials. The contractor may be required to vacate the storage space as per exigency without any extra cost.
28. The contractor shall not directly or indirectly transfer, assign or sublet the contract or any part of it.

29. The payment against the bill will be made in due course after satisfactory completion of the work

31. The intending tenderers shall pay an Earnest money Deposit of Rs 20000/- by a Demand Draft drawn on a Scheduled Bank which amount will be credited into the office of National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development. The Earnest Money Deposit will be returned to the tenderer if his tender is not accepted, but without any interest.

32. The Earnest Money Deposit of Rs 20000/- paid by the successful tenderers shall be held by the National Bank For Agriculture and Rural Development as partial deposit for the execution and fulfillment of the contract. No interest shall be paid on the said deposit.

33. The Earnest Money Deposit of the successful tenderer will be adjusted against the retention money kept by the Bank.

34. 10% of the quoted amount will be kept as retention money and will be returned to the Party at the end of the warranty period. The warranty period will be a minimum of one year from the date of handing over the system to the Bank.

35. The CCTV System after successful commissioning and testing will be duly handed over to the Bank after which the work completion certificate will be issued.

36. The Bank reserves the right to check the progress of the work and adherence to the technical specifications etc. any time during the installation phase.

37. The Party will obtain all necessary statutory approvals from the designated/approved authorities as may be required for the completion of the work.

38. The agreement may be terminated by the Bank in case the Party does not adhere to the terms of contract..

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) In the terms and conditions set in here before the term "The Bank" refers to the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), The Chief General Manager refers to Chief General Manager Incharge of the General Administration Department
- 2) "The Party" refers to the Party who has been awarded the contract for the Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Maintenance of the CCTV System at the Head Office of NABARD at Bandra- Kurla Complex, Mumbai.
- 3) All payments by the Bank under this contract will be made only at Mumbai.
- 4) All disputes arising out of or in any way connected with this Agreement shall be deemed to have arisen at Mumbai and Courts in Mumbai only shall have jurisdiction to determine the same.
- 5) That the several parts of this Contract have been read by the Party and fully understood by him/them.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into this day of 2009 between the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) having its Head Office at 'G' Block, Bandra- Kurla Complex, Bandra (East), Mumbai- 400 051, hereinafter referred to as "The Bank" and M/s hereinafter call the 'The Party'".

Whereas the Party has been awarded the Contract for the Supply, Installation, Commission and Maintenance of the CCTV System at the Head Office of the Bank, consequent upon the Bank accepting its Tender and the Party accepting the Terms and Conditions, Special Terms and Conditions and Memorandum and related items.

NOW, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESS THAT IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES:-

1. The Party will Supply, Install, Test, Commission and Maintain the CCTV System for 3 years from the date of completion of the warranty period at the Bank's Head Office for consideration of Rs. (in words). The payments will be made as per the terms indicated in the general conditions/instructions to the contractors. The party will deposit an EMD amounting to 10% of the yearly amount quoted for the Annual Maintenance Contract. The EMD will be payable by Demand Draft/Pay order drawn in favour of NABARD, Mumbai.
2. The Party agrees to replace/repair any defects in this system during the warranty period free of cost. The Party will place at the disposal of the Bank, sufficient number of technicians during the first six months to ensure proper working of the system and attend to any teething problems. The Party will carry out necessary repairs/replacement to keep the system in working condition after the warranty period on chargeable basis. The Party will charge for spare parts only as per the rate list supplied by them and agreed to by the Bank .No labour charges will be paid for any such repairs/replacement. The rates indicated should include all Taxes and Income Tax will be deducted from the bills submitted for spare parts replaced.
3. Any complaints will be attended to promptly by the Party and on no account will there be any delay in repair/replacements to ensure the smooth working of the system.
4. The Party will ensure availability of fast moving spares required for the system to ensure speedy repairs.
5. Notwithstanding what has been hitherto stated, any other matters not covered in this Agreement will be settled on mutual discussions and subject to mutual agreement.
6. The reference to the Chief General Manager in this agreement and the schedules hereto annexed shall mean the Chief General Manager holding, charge of General Administration Department for the time being at Head Office, Mumbai and shall include, in respect of any powers exercisable by him or NABARD under this agreement and any other officers of the Bank designated by him in that behalf from time to time.
7. The Party will abide with all the Terms and Conditions specified in the General conditions/instructions to the contractors.

8. All hardware and software used will be as per the details indicated by the Party in the Tender documents.

9. All the documents pertaining to the Tender will be construed as part and parcel of this agreement.

10. This agreement shall be executed in duplicate. The Bank shall retain the original and Party the duplicate. Stamp duty on original and duplicate shall be borne by the Party.
