1	<p>I Want information on application form for NABARD warehousing scheme.</p> <p>I want to apply for the loan of warehouse under your scheme. Please send the full details of the same like where I have to get the application form, how to fill, terms & conditions, eligible.</p>	<p>No application form has been prescribed.</p> <p>Request Letter along with the required information in detail, with supporting documents covering all aspects as given in Annexure-II should be submitted.</p> <p>Pl see para 5 of the Invitation document hosted at http://www.nabard.org/tender&documents.asp</p>
2	<p>Can a sole proprietor of a private firm apply for availing loan assistance for setting up warehouse infrastructure?</p>	<p>Yes, a Sole Proprietor of a private firm, provided he is engaged in setting up warehousing infrastructure, is eligible for being considered under the scheme.</p>
3	<p>Can the existing processing unit be converted into warehouse or cold storage and assistance availed under the scheme?</p>	<p>The objective of the Scheme is to increase the good quality warehousing/storage capacity. Any proposal fulfilling the objective and conforming to the technical specification may be considered.</p>
4	<p>Will an individual be eligible to apply under the scheme?</p>	<p>Individuals are eligible to apply under the scheme.</p>
5	<p>Is there any Capital Investment subsidy available for construction of warehouse in FCI PEG Scheme?</p>	<p>PEG Scheme of FCI envisages hiring of warehouses with assured rentals for a particular period. No capital subsidy is envisaged.</p>
6	<p>I am not able to find full information about warehouse project. Can you provide me customer care No. or person with I can talk?</p>	<p>Full details of NABARD (Warehousing) Scheme 2011-12 are available on NABARD's website http://www.nabard.org/tender&documents.asp Contact details of NABARD HO & Regional Offices are given in Annexure V of the Scheme.</p>

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7	<p>I have one and half acres land. Is it sufficient for construction of godowns under NABARD scheme 2011-12? What percentage of subsidy will I get from NABARD? Can I get subsidy from NABARD when I take loan from Vijaya Bank because banker is ready to provide me with loan to construct godowns?</p>	<p>You may contact an architect/civil engineer to ascertain the adequacy of land for construction of warehouse on your plot of land, as per standard technical design.</p> <p>Capital subsidy is envisaged for loans availed from banks under government schemes provided the project complies with all the terms and conditions of those schemes/programmes. You may also refer para 4. of our invitation document hosted at http://www.nabard.org/tender&documents.asp</p>
8	<p>The purpose of the rural godown will be storage of floriculture products of my nursery as well as providing storage space to other nurseries against rent. Please inform whether I am eligible for NABARD subsidy for the proposed Rural Godown and if so, what is the amount and procedure for applying for the same.</p>	<p>The objective of the Scheme is to increase good quality warehousing/storage capacity, especially for food grains.</p> <p>NABARD does not provide any subsidy.</p>
9	<p>Request you to kindly guide us on the details required for the above said scheme. We would like to know more about the requirement of details of land owned/leased for creating warehousing infrastructure (point no. 17). We would like to know as to what kind of details are required about the land.</p>	<p>Details about the land would cover aspects like title (whether owned/leased), location (state/district/ taluka, urban/rural), size (in hectare/ acre), accessibility from roads, distance to nearest rail head etc.</p>
10	<p>Owing to some financial problems, I could not construct 18 ft. height RCC roof. I believe, If I construct the same, a bulk MT of food grains will be stored here from this rural area. I shall be glad if you would kindly let me know whether I can get some financial support from your end for this construction.</p>	<p>All the warehouses to be set up under the scheme must conform to existing norms for scientific storage as prescribed by competent authorities, and must be as per the standard technical specifications. Capital subsidy is envisaged for loans availed from banks under government schemes, provided the project complies with all the terms and conditions of those schemes/programmes. 13	What will be the minimum eligibility marks for creating warehouse infrastructure for foodgrains under PEG-2008	All Agencies submitting a request letter will be listed in descending order of scores earned as per the evaluation criteria matrix. No minimum marks have been prescribed under NABARD (Warehousing) 2011-12 Scheme.
14	To avail this assistance what benefit will be provided by NABARD which is not mentioned in scheme or what extent? What will be Rate of Interest for loan and how much financial assistance will be provided by NABARD? Whether existing scheme like Gramin Bhandaran Yojna, the scheme for Development/Strengthening of Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure, Grading and Standardization etc. will be available to the unit or not?	The objective of the scheme is to create quality storage infrastructure for food grains. Cost effective financial assistance by way of loans from banks/NABARD would be made available upto a maximum of 80% of the project cost. Capital subsidy is envisaged for loans availed from banks under government schemes, provided the project complies with all the terms and conditions of those schemes/programmes.
