National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) invites sealed quotations for Supply , installation , testing and commissioning of water purifier in the staff and officers' quarters of NABARD at Chandrasekharapur, Bhubaneswar. Offers may be submitted as per the detailed specification and schedule of quantities enclosed with the tender document.
2. Tenderers are requested to submit their most competitive offer in a sealed envelope, superscribed with "Offer for Supply , installation , testing and commissioning of water purifier in the staff and officers' quarters at Chandrasekharapur, Bhubaneswar " and addressed to The Chief General Manager , National Bank for Agriculture & Rural Development, Orissa Regional Office, "ANKUR", 2/1 Nayapalli, Civic Center, Bhubaneswar – 751 015. The sealed envelope containing the Tender shall be submitted to Premises Section in 3rd floor at our Office not later than 1400 Hrs. on 31 May 2011.
3. Your sealed Envelope should contain the following :

 - e-General terms and conditions/ instructions to bidders
 - f-Duly filled in Schedule of Quantities
4. Tenders will be opened on the same date i.e. on 31 May 2011 at 15.00 hrs. in the presence of bidders / their authorized representatives, who choose to be present. In case , the date is revised by the Bank , the same will be conveyed to the tenderers. Tenders received late on account of any reason whatsoever as also telegraphic and Faxed tenders shall not be entertained. The tenderers shall not include any conditions of their own whatsoever. In case any conditions are included, the same shall not be taken into consideration. The tender in such cases is liable to be rejected.
5. ***A Pre-bid meeting will be held on 25 May 2011 at 14.00 PM in the conference room of the NABARD Regional Office at the above said address. The bidders are requested to attend the meeting and obtain clarifications, if any, required by them. No further requests for clarifications shall be entertained. The firms may bring the catalogues , water test reports and they are requested to give demonstration of the equipment quoted by them on that day .***
6. Time for completion of the work of supply and installation of the water purifier complete in all respects shall be 30 days from the date of issue of Work Order by the Bank.
7. Liquidated Damages for delay shall be 0.25% (Zero Point two five percentage only) of the accepted cost of quotation per week upto a maximum of 5% (Five percent only) of the contract value .

8. The firm will submit warrantee certificate for each instruments during which the contractor shall maintain the equipment in normal working condition free of cost.
9. Validity of Offer shall be 60 days from the date of opening of quotation.
10. If you need any clarifications on any point before submitting quotation, you may visit / contact our office at the address / phone mentioned above during office hours on any working day.
11. NABARD reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders at it's sole discretion and the work may be divided and awarded separately amongst the tenderers, without assigning any reason for doing so.
12. All documents that comprise the offer should be duly stamped and signed by authorised person of the firm.
13. The Employer does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders, either in whole or in part, without assigning any reason for doing so.

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT made at Bhubaneswar on this _____ day of 2011 between the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), a body corporate constituted under the NABARD Act, 1981 and having its Head Office at C-24, 'G' Block Bandra-Kurla Complex, Bandra (E), Mumbai-400 051 and its Orissa Regional Office at Nayapalli , Bhubaneswar-751015 (herein after called 'the Employer' which expression shall unless repugnant to the context, mean and include its successors and assigns) of the one part;

AND

(Hereinafter called "the Contractor" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, mean and include) successors and assigns of the other part

WHEREAS

1. The Employer is desirous of installing water purifiers in the staff / officers quarters of NABARD referred to as "the said work") .
2. The pages duly numbered from _____ to _____ of the tender document have been duly signed by or on _____ behalf of the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor/s have agreed to execute the said works subject to the provisions hereinafter contained and subject also to Notice inviting tender, form of tender , instructions to the bidders, General Conditions of Contract, Safety Code ,Technical Specifications (all of which are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "said conditions") strictly in accordance with the specifications and schedule of quantities referred to above at or for the respective rates set out in the Schedule of Rates annexed hereto amounting to the sum as thereunder arrived at or such other sums as shall become payable thereunder (herein after referred to as the "said contract amount.)

NOW THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT:

- ii) In consideration of the said contract amount to be paid by the Employer to the Contractor at the time and in the manner set forth in the said conditions and in accordance with the Schedule of payments and complete the work as described in the said Specifications and Schedule of Quantities with due care and diligence.
- iii) The said Conditions and the Annexure thereto shall be read and construed as forming a part of this agreement and the parties hereto shall strictly abide by, submit themselves to the said conditions and perform the agreements on their part respectively contained in the said conditions.
4. This Contract neither a fixed Lump sum Contract nor a Piece work Contract but is a contract to carry out the work complete in all respects to be paid for according to the actual measured quantities at the rates contained in the Schedule of Quantities as provided in the said conditions.
5. The Employer reserves to itself the right of altering the nature of the work through the Bank by adding to or omitting any items of work or having portions of the same carried out without prejudice to this contract.

6. The tenderer hereby affirms that he has experienced and competent staff that will enable them to ensure proper quality check on the materials, and who will ensure that proper tests as required are carried out and will supervise the day-to-day working and execution of the contract works.
7. The tenderer covenants and warrants that completed items of the work as well as the entire work on completion will be in conformity with the specifications and the terms and conditions of this contract and will be of proper quality and description.
8. Time shall be considered as the essence of this Contract and the Contractor hereby agrees to commence the work immediately from the date of Work Order and shall complete the entire work within 30 days subject nevertheless to the provisions of extension of time as contained in the said conditions.
9. The Contract herein contained shall comprise not only the works mentioned above but all subsidiary works connected therewith within the same site as may be ordered to be done from time to time by the Employer for the time being, even if such work may not be described in the said Schedule of specifications and Quantities.
10. All payments by the Employer under this Contract will be made only at Bhubaneswar by cheque only.
11. All disputes arising out of or in any way connected with this agreement shall be deemed to have arisen at Bhubaneswar and only courts in Bhubaneswar shall have jurisdiction to determine the same.
12. This agreement shall be signed in duplicate, the original whereof shall be kept in the custody of the Employer and the duplicate with the Contractor, stamp duty shall be borne and paid by Contractor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Employer has set its hands hereunto and two duplicates hereof through its duly authorized official and Contractor has caused, these presents and two duplicates hereof under its common seal/ by its authorized representative at the place and on the date and year first herein-above written.

General Terms and Conditions / Instructions to the Contractors

1. The contractors are advised to visit the site and understand the nature and scope of the work and doubts of any nature should be got clarified before quoting.
2. Rates should include charges for removal of debris out of premises, removing stains, cleaning the site thoroughly and restoring it to original condition where work is undertaken.
3. Quoted rate shall be workable and should include all overheads and profits.
4. Rates shall include all taxes , duties , octroi , levies, wages service tax, work contract tax etc, and should be firm for the entire contract period. No variation in the rates and change in tax will be entertained.
5. Materials used should conform to the stipulations as in the relevant IS. Codes (Latest Edition). BIS & CPWD specification shall be followed as applicable. However, in the absence of the same the decision of NABARD will be final and binding.
6. The contractor shall submit the bill after completion of work. The contractor can submit interim bills and the minimum value of interim bills would be Rs.5 lakh. the final bill will be submitted after completion of the entire work. The bill will be settled after successful completion of work, physical verification, testing and measurement of the work. No advance payment will be entertained.
7. Income tax and any other taxes as applicable will be deducted from total payment due to the contractor.
8. Any discrepancy in settlement of bills may be brought to the notice of the Bank within a period of one month after the settlement of the Bills. The bank will not entertain any claim regarding any dispute in settlement of the bills after stipulated period.
9. The contractor should have valid electrical contractors license relating to his contract and the workmen employed by the contractor should have valid wireman / electrician license and experience in their trade.
10. The items not covered in the schedule of quantities shall be paid on the basis of market rates or the company's price list (to be made available by the contractor) plus 15% profit and overheads.
11. Contractors should abide by the minimum wages act and other statutory provisions related to the contracts in force from time to time.
12. The working hours to be observed by the contractors shall generally be from 9.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. However, in the case of emergency, work will have to be continued till the same is completed for which no extra payment shall be made.
13. In case of any doubts, clarification to be sought from the concerned officer/Bank's Engineer.

14. All the standard conditions of the contract shall be binding on the Contractor.
15. Bank reserves the right to accept/reject any quotations / tender either in whole or in part without assigning any reasons therefor, whatsoever.
16. The contract can be terminated by the Bank on 15 days notice if work is not found to be satisfactory.
17. The contractor should arrange to obtain necessary insurance cover for his employees. He would be responsible for the safety of persons employed by him. The bank shall not carry any responsibility in case of any accident to his worker inside the premises. During the execution period, the contractor shall take full responsibility for the care of the work and take precautions to prevent loss or damage to the work. The contractor shall be liable for any damage or loss that may arise to the said work and will make good the damage at their cost.
18. Technical Inspection :- All works carried out must be technically sound and acceptable to the Bank. These works shall be inspected by the Bank's Engineer before payment.
19. All works shall be carried out under guidance of Bank's Engineer and Caretaker in-charge.
20. Liaison work with CESU / Electricity authorities will have to be done by the contractor as and when required.
21. The replacement (wherever payable extra) shall be done only on written permission of the bank.
22. The contractor should not at any time do, cause or permit any nuisance on the site/do anything which shall cause unnecessary disturbances or inconvenience to the occupants / visitors at site or near the site of work.
23. The workers employed by the contractor can use the common facilities such as drinking water, toilet, etc. at designated places, provided at the premises. However, it should be ensured that the same should be kept in hygienic condition.
24. The workman employed by the contractor should abide by the rules and regulations for the premises especially on the working hours, entry of the workers to the premises, interpersonal relation with the staff members.
25. The contractor should obtain approvals, if any, necessary for the work from the statutory bodies on behalf of the bank. The fees, if any, will be borne by the contractor.
26. The contractor shall not directly or indirectly transfer, assign or sublet the contract or any part of it.
27. The Contractor shall comply with all the applicable Acts, Rules, Regulations, requirement of Law(s) for executing the work and the bank will not in any way be liable or responsible for any default/irregularities/penalties on the contractor's part.

28. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of Contract, Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, Minimum Wages Act and all other labour laws and other Statutory Regulations (both Central and States) that may be enforced from time to time by the appropriate authorities. The bank shall not be held responsible for any penalty on failure of the any labour regulations. The bank shall have the power to inspect the wage books and physical verification of salary paid to the staff, muster books and any other records of the contractor and to ask the contractor to comply with Laws.
29. The contractor should be responsible to fulfill all the obligations in connection with the workers employed by the contractor for the purpose of the contract and all the Statutory and other liabilities if any including minimum wages, leave salary, uniform, ex-gratia, gratuity, ESI, Provident Fund. Workman Compensation, if any, etc. in connection therewith shall be on the contractor account and payable by the concerned contractor.
30. The contractor should obtain necessary permission that may be required for the purpose of this contract from such authorities as may be prescribed by law from time to time.
31. The contractor or his authorised supervisor should supervise the works and should be available at the site as required.
32. The contractor should provide uniform to his workers engaged at site. The contractor should arrange to issue photo identity card for which no extra payment will be made.
33. The contractor shall be fully responsible and shall compensate the bank in the event of any damage to men or material, injury / damage or death as the case may be , caused directly or indirectly due to the negligence of the contractor or his agents and / or his employees or workmen. The decision of the bank in this regard shall be final and binding.
34. The contractor should not employ any person who is prohibited by law from being employed for fulfilling obligations under this contract.
35. Any act of indiscipline/misconduct/theft/pilferage on the part of any employee engaged by the contractor resulting in any loss to the bank in kind or cash will be viewed seriously and the bank will have the right to levy damages or fine and / or even terminate the contract forthwith or remove such offending employee of the contractor from the works.
36. In case of any default or failure on contractor's part to comply with all / any one of the terms / conditions, the bank reserves to itself the right to take necessary steps to remedy the situation including, inter-alia, the deduction of appropriate amounts from dues otherwise payable to contractor and / or by taking recourse to appropriate recovery proceedings.
37. In case of dispute, if any, regarding need for replacement of a particular item, the decision of the bank shall be final.

38. The tenderer is advised to go through the tender terms and conditions and the person so authorised to sign, should sign all the pages of tender documents including conditions of contract.
39. On site storage space will be given subject to availability the security of which will be the responsibility of the contractor. The bank will not be responsible for loss of contractor's material. The contractor may be required to vacate the storage space as per exigency without any extra cost .
40. The contractor will deposit 2 % of the accepted contract amount as Initial security deposit after the acceptance of the work order. 5 % of the contract amount (including initial security deposit) will be retained by the Bank as RETENTION MONEY DEPOSIT (RMD) from the bills, the 50 % of which will be released on issue of virtual completion of the work and remaining 50 % will be retained with the Bank as security deposit. The Security Deposit (SD) will not bear any interest . Security deposit is refunded after Defects Liability Period of 12 months from the date of Completion of works provided the Contractor has satisfactorily carried out all the rectification works and attended to all defects to the satisfaction of NABARD.
41. The contractor shall provide everything necessary for proper execution of the work. No payment shall be made by the Bank for P&T material to be provided by the contractor . Water and electricity may be provided by the Bank subject to availability with prior permission of the bank. However , the contractor have to maintain such electrical and plumbing equipments in proper order.
42. The firm is required to sign an agreement with the NABARD within 07 days of the issue of award of work as per the articles of agreement.
43. **Scope of work**

The work includes supply and installation of domestic water purifier in the kitchen of the staff and officers ' quarters of NABARD , Bhubaneswar. The firm will make necessary arrangements for mounting the instrument in the wall at a suitable place. Associated fittings , pipes and water connection will be provided to the instrument to ensure proper functioning of the equipment. A suitable cover prescribed by the manufacturer should be provided for the equipment. The work should be carried out neatly in a systematic manner. The bidders are required to collect water samples from staff and officers quarters and submit test reports along with the tender. The bidders should quote for the best model suitable for the quality of water so available. The firms may also present the copy of the test reports in the pre-bid meeting for discussion and to arrive at a consensus on the best models required for our site.

Brief technical specification of the equipment

- i)The equipment should have 3 stage advanced filtering process. In the process of purification sediment filter , carbon filter and UV filter of IS standards should be used. It should remove physical impurities, dissolved impurities, organic impurities, unpleasant odour , colour etc.. The ultra violet treatment should give complete protection from all water borne disease causing bacteria and virus. The equipment should be of the latest technology. The machine should deliver the desired quality of water as per IS standards. The firm is required to test the same , show to the occupants and take signature of each occupants after successful installation.
- ii)It should have power saving feature and auto shut off feature in absence of flow of water.

iii)It should be built to withstand voltage fluctuation and operate within a wide range of input voltage i.e. from 140 to 270 V in single phase, 50 Hz.

iv)It should have electronic / microprocessor based monitoring system to monitor the purification process and give indication for malfunction of consumables.
The % age of mineral contents should be at the desired level.

v)Efficient after sales service should be available at doorstep.

vi) Following credentials may be submitted along the tender:

Laboratory test certificate for water purification process

ISI test certificate

Certification from Indian medical Association

Warranty Certificate

Water test report

The bidders should submit proper justification for quoting the particular model clearly indicating its merits/ advantages over similar products in the market.

45. Safety Precautions

The contractor shall observe all the safety precautions for the safety of the labourers and the employees of the Bank during execution of works. As a part of the contract, the Contractor must satisfy the under mentioned safety requirements and must ensure at all times that these are followed without any deviations:

- a. Smoking is prohibited.
- b. Any job where welding, soldering etc. required , lighting of flame or use of source of heat or temporary electrical connections shall not be done without prior permission from the Bank's Technical Officer. No job involving heat sources are permitted to be carried out after office hours, holidays and Sunday without prior permission.
- c. It is entirely the responsibility of the Contractor to see the safety appliances such as safety belts, life lines, helmets, rubber gloves etc. depending on the job are made available to his staff at Contractor's cost. If the Contractor needs any suggestion on the matter, he can approach the Bank's Officer-in-Charge however any lapse on safety will be viewed seriously.
- d.The Contractor shall ensure that the persons posted for the work are well conversant with the operation of fire extinguishers.
- e.The Contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accident and causes of accident. He must be careful regarding safety during working of his staff in the premises.

46. Safety Precautions of portable electrical appliances

Precaution in handling portable electrical appliances are more significant under monsoon conditions. Some likely situations are highlighted here for your attention and action to ensure that conditions and methods of usage conform to safety of personnel and property.

i) Joints in flexible cables

Usage of portable appliance is such that electrical and physical integrity of joint may be suddenly affected, leading to severe sparking and fire takes place if combustible or flammable materials are lying at the joint. Perhaps this may not be noticed by operator at all. For this and similar reasons, joints in cables of portable appliances are not permitted at all.

ii) Appliance body grounding and system grounding

In the absence of or ineffective appliance body grounding, operator may receive severe shock in case of phase to body fault during usage. Further, all earth pin socket must have low impedance and mechanically firm earthing according to Indian Electricity Rules so that safety is assured to operator even under fault conditions.

iii) Water leakage

Water reduces efficiency of insulation depending upon exposure. Presence of moisture on ordinary switches may give a shock during operation. Switches in chronic leakage areas should preferably be de-energised until rectification is done and contractors must apprise civil works and properties department.

iv) Excavation / Additions / Alterations of Building etc.

During excavations, alternations of buildings etc. every care shall be taken that electric shock or damage to cable, etc. are avoided. De-energisation of circuits must be considered whenever required.
