

Recruitment for the Post of Assistant Manager/Manager - 2016
General Information for the Candidates

The process for recruitment of Assistant Manager / Manager 2016 is underway. Various candidates have been requesting NABARD for information regarding the recruitment process through RTI application. Some of the common issues indicated by the candidates and information thereon is given below so that they do not resort to applications /e-mails under RTI Act.

1. Marks obtained by the candidates in Phase I – Preliminary Examination held on 15th May 2016 / Phase II – Main Examination held on 12 June 2016 :

The marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination were made available to the candidates through an online interface on our website (www.nabard.org). The interface was open till 17 July 2016. The marks of Phase II – Main Examination have been sent by e-mail to all concerned candidates.

2. Question Paper / Answer Sheets for Phase II – Main Examination – English (Descriptive) Paper held on 12th June 2016:

The Phase II – Main Examination was conducted by IBPS, a recruitment agency engaged by NABARD and the candidates were required to write the descriptive answers online and as such, question paper / answer sheet for the above examination are not available with NABARD.

3. Answer Keys :

NABARD is not maintaining a database of answer keys.

4. Rechecking / Revaluation of the Paper :

The papers are online and fully computerised. The system takes care of totalling, etc. of the marks with necessary checks and balances. Examination and system based evaluation were done by IBPS and NABARD has no mechanism for rechecking of paper.

5. Sectional and Overall Cut-off Marks :

Cut off Marks are the standard practice followed by IBPS for banking industry with a view to select candidates suiting institutional requirements.

6. Break-up of Marks of separate Sections in Paper II of the Main Examination :

The break-up of marks for Paper II of the Main Examination viz., Economic and Social Issues and Agriculture and Rural Development is not available with NABARD.

7. Interview :

The detailed schedule for interviews to be held for the above posts has been placed on our website. While interview for candidates from northern States will be held in New Delhi, for the remaining candidates, it will be held at Mumbai. The interview

centres viz. New Delhi / Mumbai have been allotted based on the place of domicile / residential address of the candidates. It has no relation to the places from where the candidates appeared for the Preliminary or Main Examination. No request for change of centre for interview will be entertained.

8. Composition of the Interview Committee

Composition of the Interview Committee is as per guidelines of Govt. of India.

9. Bio-data of the candidates appearing for Interview :

Candidates who will be appearing for the interview have to send their Bio-data in the prescribed format attached with the interview call letter in PDF format by e-mail to recruitment@nabard.org latest by 29th July 2016.

10. Number of candidates from SC/ST/OBC/PWD categories, etc. :

The information regarding number of SC/ST/OBC/PWD appearing at different stages of exam & interview will be provided after the recruitment process is complete.

11. Announcement of Result – Select List and Wait List

The select list and wait list will be announced tentatively in the last week of November 2016 after completion of the interview and any enquiry from the candidates for declaration of the result / select / wait list will not be entertained. The Roll Number of the candidates selected for appointment will be released on our website.

12. Reimbursement of Travelling Expenditure to the candidates attending Interview

The candidates attending the interview are eligible for claiming Travel / Journey Expenditure from the declared place of residence to the interview centre for journey by train AC – II Tier. The candidates are required to carry documents in support of their travel claim as detailed in the interview call letter. The reimbursement of eligible amount will be made through e-payment.

13. Candidate who has topped in the Examination :

Information regarding the topper or marks of the candidates other than himself/herself will not be released in terms of provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

14. Next Examination for Recruitment of Officers :

Candidates may keep watch on the next advertisement, if any, which will be released on our website as also in leading newspapers. The candidates are advised to refer to the Careers page on our website : www.nabard.org.
