Limited Tender Notice for Repair & Renovation Work of Nabard Flats No.- 805 & 806 at Himgiri Apartment, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad (U.P.)- 201012

1. National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), New Delhi Regional Office, New Delhi invites tender **from the empanelled vendors only (Limited Tender Process)** for the captioned work.
2. NABARD intends to undertake the **Repairs & Renovation Works in NABARD Officers' Flats No. -805 & 806 at Himgiri Apartment, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad (U.P.)- 201012.**
3. **The vendors empanelled in Category-III (for works up to Rs. 5.00 lakh to 15 lakh) or Category-IV (for works above Rs. 15 lakh and up to Rs. 50 lakh) in both Civil and Electrical Works in Trade 1.1 (General Civil, Sanitary, Plumbing & Carpentry works) and 2.1 (General repair and maintenance) respectively are eligible to apply.**
4. The tender can be downloaded from the Bank's website <https://www.nabard.org>.
5. The Tenders, duly filled and complete in all respects, may be submitted in a sealed cover clearly superscribing it as **"Limited Tender Notice for Repair & Renovation Work of Nabard Flats No.- 805 & 806 at Himgiri Apartment, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad (U.P.)- 201012"** to the General Manager/OIC, NABARD, New Delhi Regional Office, 24, Rajendra Place, New Delhi – 110008.
6. The tenderer/bidder shall submit a single bid for the captioned work i.e. Price/Financial Bid which should be complete in all respects.
7. Instructions regarding **Tender, submission process and description & scope of works** and the services required have been elaborated in the Terms and Conditions of the tender and other parts of the tender document.
8. A **Pre-Bid meeting** is not required.
9. The last date & time for submission of application is up to **10:30 AM on 13/03/2025**. Tenders received after stipulated date and time shall not be entertained.
10. The Tenders/Financial Bids will be opened on **13/03/2025 at 11:30 AM** in **NABARD Tower 24, Rajendra Place New Delhi- 110008** in the presence of interested bidders who chose to be present or in any eventuality, on the date and time as decided by NABARD. All the bidders are advised in their own interest to be present on the specified date. No separate intimation will be given in this regard. Please note, not more than two representatives from each bidder shall be entertained. The representative has to furnish an authorization letter from the respective bidder on their letterhead for participating in the tender/financial bid opening.

11. NABARD does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid (L1). NABARD reserves the right to accept or reject any /all tender/s in part or whole of any firm / firms without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
12. The decision of the bank shall be final and binding with regard to price bids and the tendering process.
13. The tender will be rejected, if any bidder proposes any deviation from the prescribed technical criteria requirement.
14. Tenderers must ensure attachment of relevant documents and Annexures.
15. The price bid shall remain valid and open for acceptance for 90 days from the date of opening of Price Bid.
16. **Time of Completion:** The work shall be completed within 45 days from the date of acceptance of work order.
17. All documents that comprise the offer should be signed and sealed by the firm, as a token of acceptance to the terms and conditions specified in the tender.
18. **Liquidated damages** for delay in completion of the works will be levied at 0.25% of the value of work for every week of delay or part thereof, subject to maximum of 5% on the incomplete value of the accepted tender.
19. NABARD reserves the right to accept or reject any /all tender/s in part or whole of any firm / firms without assigning any reasons whatsoever. The decision of the Bank in this regard shall be final. In the event of intending tenderers failure to satisfy the bank, the bank reserved the right to reject the tender.
20. NABARD reserves right to change/modify/amend any or all provisions of the tender document. Such revision/amendment or corrigendum/addendum, if any, will be made available on NABARD's website only (Open Tender) and through Email (Limited Tender).
21. Tenderer should inspect the existing site and other conditions up to their satisfaction before tendering /bidding.
22. Applications containing false and/or incomplete information are liable for rejection
23. The work shall be done in strict coordination with the Bank as per directions issued and within the stipulated timeframe in an expeditious manner.
24. The successful bidder shall execute an 'Articles of Agreement' (Annexure-E) of work contract with NABARD in accordance with the standard / prescribed format within 10 days from the date of acceptance of the offer.
25. Estimated cost of the work is Rs. 14,99,000/- inclusive of GST.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

1. The tenders shall be signed by the person/persons on behalf of the organization having necessary Authorization/Power of Attorney to do so. Each page of the application shall be signed. (Copy of Power of Attorney/Memorandum of Association shall be furnished along with applications).
2. The rates for each item as per scope of work shall be quoted by the applicant in the **Price bid**.
3. The Tender is strictly on Item Rate basis. The estimated cost of the work is **Rs. 14.99 lakhs** (approximately).
4. All the pages of the Tender Document shall be signed and duly stamped by the Tenderer.
5. NABARD takes no responsibility for delay / loss in post or non-receipt of Tender Documents.
6. Bids submitted by unauthorized agents and fax bids shall not be entertained/considered.
7. Tenderers are advised to visit the **site at their cost, conduct survey of existing conditions so as to familiarize themselves with the site conditions, nature of works etc.** and get all clarifications as necessary from NABARD before quoting the rates.
8. Rates should include amount for removal of debris out of premises to the safe limit, removing stains, cleaning the site thoroughly and unless the same is done to the satisfaction of the NABARD's Engineer/representative, the Bill will not be accepted.
9. The Contractor shall make necessary arrangement for watch and ward of his materials, tools, and machines, Scaffolding & Retrofitting/Repairs etc. stored for the execution of the work at his own risk and cost and NABARD will not be responsible on any account.
10. The Tenderers should quote their rates strictly adhering to Terms and Conditions stipulated in the Tender Document. Unsolicited correspondence after opening of the Tender shall not be entertained. Conditional / deviational tenders may be rejected without making any reference to the Tenderers.
11. No Tenderer will be allowed to withdraw his Tender during the validity period. Subletting of the Contract is not permitted.
12. Rates should be filled in the Tender neatly and as far as possible, no correction shall be made quoting for all items in price bid is mandatory, no fields should be left blank. The rates quoted should be written legibly in words and figures. If on check, differences are observed between the rates given by the Contractor in words and figures in words shall be taken as correct. All the quotes to be rounded off at all stages. If any bidder quotes price without rounding off then NABARD at its liberty to round off the quotes to arrive at the lowest bid.
13. All the rates mentioned for the items in the documents shall be exclusive of all the GST. GST shall be paid additional as per Bank's policy.

This Tender Document has been prepared solely for the purpose of enabling NABARD in defining the requirements for engaging the Contractor for execution of **Repair & Renovation Work of Nabard Flats No.- 805 & 806 at Himgiri Apartment, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad (U.P.)- 201012** as mentioned in the Scope of Work.
4. The Tender Document is not a recommendation, offer or invitation to enter into a contract, agreement or any other arrangement in respect of the services. The provision of the services is subject to observance of selection process and appropriate documentation being agreed between NABARD and any successful Bidder as identified by NABARD after completion of the selection process.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The contractor to indemnify NABARD for any complications.
2. The quantities indicated in the price bid are only tentative and shall be executed only at the sole discretion of NABARD.
3. The Drawings attached are indicative and only for a fair idea of the bidder. After the demolition, NABARD/Architect may do a reorientation/ re alignment of the components like Sanitary fittings and fixtures, Accessories, CP fittings, Electrical and Electronic components. Although the numbers, quality and models of the components shall remain same.
4. Quoted rates should be workable and reasonable and should include incidental and all overheads and profits. **The contractor should furnish Rate Analysis for scrutiny of the rates by NABARD, if required.**
5. No escalation of rates will be allowed for the entire contract period on any account.
6. All the materials shall comply with the specifications and model numbers mentioned in the BOQ.
7. Any generic item like cement, sand, steel etc shall also be conforming to the approval of NABARD Representative. Method of Measurements shall be as agreed and share by the NABARD Representative on the site. However, in the absence of the same and / or in case of any discrepancy, the decision of NABARD will be considered final.
8. Any items not covered in the Schedule of Quantities of the Contract Document shall be paid at the rates as per Rate Analysis based on the market prices supported by documentary proof with 15% towards Contractor's OHP plus Works Contract Tax and Service Tax, as applicable. The Rate Analysis shall be submitted by the Contractor for scrutiny and approval of NABARD.
9. Specifications and Method of Measurements shall be followed as applicable. However, in the absence of the same and / or in case of any discrepancy, the decision of NABARD will be final.
10. The Contractor should have valid License relating to his Contract and the workmen employed by the Contractor should also have the valid License and experience in their trade.
11. The Contractor should arrange to obtain necessary **insurance cover (Workmen Compensation Policy)** for his employees at his cost and should be solely responsible for the safety of persons, employed by him.
12. All the Standard Conditions of the Contract shall be binding on the parties as per Indian Contract Act and prevailing Rules.
13. The entire work is required to be completed as specified in the tender.
14. The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Contract, Labor (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, Minimum Wages Act and all other Labor Laws and other Statutory Regulations (both Central and State) that may be enforced from time to time by the appropriate authorities. NABARD shall not be held responsible for any penalty on failure of the any Labor Regulations. NABARD shall have the power to inspect the Wage Register and for physical verification of salary paid to the staff with reference to any records of the Contractor and to insist the Contractor to comply with Laws.
15. The Contractor should be responsible to fulfil all the obligations in connection with the workers employed by the Contractor for the purpose of the Contract and all the Statutory and other liabilities, if any, including

minimum wages, leave salary, uniform, ex-gratia, gratuity, ESI, Provident Fund, Workman Compensation, if any, etc. in connection therewith shall be on the Contractor's account and payable by the Contractor.

14. The Contractor should obtain necessary permission that may be required for the purpose of this Contract from such authorities as may be prescribed by Law from time to time.
15. The Contractor or his authorized representative should visit the site frequently as required by NABARD and meet NABARD's Engineer with prior appointment for any clarifications and to receive instructions, take measurements, etc. at the site.
16. **The contractor should engage a qualified and experienced technical personnel in respective Engineering fields to supervise the work on daily basis as per the instructions of the Bank's Engineer/Official.** The supervisor shall maintain daily log book for the work done at site and the labor deployed.
17. The Contractor shall be fully responsible and shall obtain a suitable Insurance cover in respect of any damage to men or material, injury / damage or death as the case may be, caused directly or indirectly during the execution of works by the Contractor. A copy of such insurance shall be submitted to NABARD. The decision of NABARD in this regard shall be final and binding
18. The contractor shall indemnify the Employer against any losses as per format given at **Annexure-A.**
19. Any act of indiscipline / misconduct / theft / pilferage on the part of any employee engaged by the Contractor resulting in any loss to NABARD in kind or cash will be viewed seriously and NABARD will have the right to claim damages or levy fine and / or terminate the Contract forthwith, if necessary.
20. In case of any default or failure on Contractor's part to comply with all / any one of the Terms / Conditions, NABARD reserves to itself the right to take necessary steps to remedy the situation including, inter-alia, the deduction of appropriate amount from dues otherwise payable to Contractor and / or by taking recourse to appropriate recovery proceedings.
21. If any dispute arises on any matter concerning this Contract, the decision of NABARD shall be final and binding.
22. The Contractor should not at any time do, cause or permit any nuisance on the site / do anything which shall cause unnecessary disturbances or inconvenience to the occupants/visitors at site or near the site of work.
23. The contractor by his own expenses and risk shall shift furniture, wall pictures/frames, clocks, other fixtures etc., if any, in the area of work carefully and without any damage to a convenient place under intimation to the Bank for the convenience of work and shall reinstall the same in old place after completion of work.
24. The work should be carried out with least inconvenience to the occupants. The workmen employed by the Contractor should abide by the Rules and Regulations maintained by NABARD in the premises, especially in respect of working hours, entry of the workers to the premises, interpersonal relation with the occupants etc.
25. The Contractor should obtain approvals, if any, necessary for carrying out the work, from the statutory bodies on behalf of NABARD. However, NABARD may assist the Contractor in respect of any liaison with the Municipal or any other authority for necessary approval / permission with regard to the construction / maintenance works. The fees and other statutory charges, if any, will be reimbursed to the Contractor based on the original receipts produced to NABARD.
26. The Contract can be terminated by NABARD on 15 days' notice if services are found to be unsatisfactory and if there is no improvement even after issue of three notices to the contractor.
27. **Performance of Work:** The Contractor shall provide everything necessary for the proper execution of the works. All the Works shall be executed in strict conformity with the provisions of the CONTRACT Documents and with such explanatory detailed drawings, specification and instructions as may be furnished from time to time to the CONTRACTOR by the NABARD Representative/NABARD whether mentioned in the CONTRACT or not. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for ensuring that works throughout are executed

in the most substantial, proper and workmanlike manner with the quality of material and workmanship in strict accordance with the SPECIFICATIONS and to the entire satisfaction of the NABARD Representative /NABARD. The CONTRACTOR shall provide all necessary materials equipment labor etc. for execution and maintenance of WORK till completion unless otherwise mentioned in the CONTRACT.

28. **Coordination and Inspection of Work:** The coordination and inspection of the day-to-day work under the CONTRACT shall be the responsibility of the NABARD representative. The written instruction regarding any particular job will normally be passed by the NABARD Representative or his authorized representative. A work order book will be maintained by the CONTRACTOR for each sector in which the aforesaid written instructions will be entered. These will be signed by the CONTRACTOR or his authorized representative by way of acknowledgement within 12 hours.
29. **Work on Sundays and holidays:** For carrying out Work on Sundays and Holidays, the CONTRACTOR will approach the NABARD Representative/NABARD or his representative at least two days in advance and obtain permission in writing. The CONTRACTOR shall observe all labor laws and other statutory rules and regulations in force. In case of any violations of such laws, rules and regulations, consequence if any, including the cost thereto shall be exclusively borne by the CONTRACTOR and the EMPLOYER shall have no liability whatsoever on this account.
30. **Discrepancies between instructions:** Should any discrepancy occur between the various instructions furnished to the CONTRACTOR, his agent or staff or any doubt arises as to the meaning of any such instructions or should there be any misunderstanding between the CONTRACTOR's staff and the NABARD representative's staff, the CONTRACTOR shall refer the matter immediately in writing to the NABARD Representative whose decision thereon shall be final and conclusive and no claim for losses alleged to have been caused by such discrepancies between instructions, doubts, or misunderstanding shall in any event be admissible.
31. **Action where no specification is issued:** In case of any class of WORK for which there is no SPECIFICATION supplied by the EMPLOYER as mentioned in the Tender Documents such WORK shall be carried out in accordance with **Indian Standard Specifications** and if the Indian Standard Specifications do not cover the same, the WORK should be carried out as per standard Engineering Practice subject to the approval of the NABARD Representative.
32. **Inspection of works:** The NABARD Representative will have full power and authority to inspect the WORK at any time wherever in progress either on the SITE or at the CONTRACTOR's premises/workshops wherever situated, premises/ workshops of any person, firm or corporation where WORK in connection with the CONTRACT may be in hand or where materials are being or are to be supplied, and the CONTRACTOR shall afford or procure for the NABARD Representative every facility and assistance to carry out such inspection. The CONTRACTOR shall, at all time during the usual working hours and at all other time at which reasonable notice of the intention of the NABARD Representative or his representative to visit the WORK shall have been given to the CONTRACTOR, either himself be present or receive orders and instructions, or have a responsible agent duly accredited in writing, present for the purpose. Orders given to the CONTRACTOR's agent shall be considered to have the same force as if they had been given to the CONTRACTOR himself. The CONTRACTOR shall give not less than seven day notice in writing to the NABARD Representative before covering up or otherwise placing beyond reach of inspection and measurement of any work in order that the same may be inspected and measured. In the event of breach of above the same shall be uncovered at CONTRACTOR's expense for carrying out such measurement or inspection. The CONTRACTOR is to provide at all time during the progress of the WORK and the maintenance period, proper means of access with ladders, gangways etc. and the necessary attendance to move and adopt as directed for inspection or measurements of the WORK by the NABARD representative. The CONTRACTOR shall make available to the NABARD Representative free of cost all necessary instruments and assistance in checking or setting out of WORK and in the checking of any WORK made by the CONTRACTOR for the purpose of setting out and taking measurements of WORK. The NABARD Representative shall have the right to take possession of or use any completed

or partially completed WORK or part of the WORK. Such possession or use shall not be deemed to be an acceptance of any work completed in accordance with the CONTRACT agreement. If such prior possession or use by the NABARD Representative delays the progress of WORK, equitable adjustment in the time of completion will be made and the CONTRACT agreement shall be deemed to be modified accordingly.

- 33. Procedure for measurement and billing of work in progress:** Following procedures shall be adopted for billing of works executed by the CONTRACTOR.
- a. All measurements shall be recorded on standard measurement sheets supplied by EMPLOYER and submitted to EMPLOYER/REPRESENTATIVE for scrutiny and passing.
 - b. EMPLOYER/ REPRESENTATIVE shall scrutinize and check the measurements recorded on the sheets and shall certify correctness of the same on the measurement sheets.
 - c. NABARD Representative shall pass the bills after carrying out the comprehensive checks in accordance with the terms and conditions of the CONTRACTS, within 7 days of submission of the bills, complete in all respects and send the same to the EMPLOYER to effect payment to the CONTRACTOR.
 - d. While raising running bill, the contractor to indicate item wise quantity sanctions, quantity completed, claim already received for specific quantity claimed under the current bill.
 - e. NABARD shall make all endeavor to make payments of undisputed amount of the bills submitted based on the joint measurements within 15 (fifteen) working days from the date of certification by the NABARD Representative.
 - f. Measurements shall be recorded as per the methods of measurement spelt out in EMPLOYER/NABARD SPECIFICATIONS / CONTRACT DOCUMENT. NABARD shall be fully responsible for checking the measurements quantitatively and qualitatively as recorded in the Measurement Books/ Bills.
 - g. While preparing the final bills overall measurements will not be taken again. Only volume of work executed since the last measured bill along with summary of final measurements will be considered for the final bill. However, a detailed check shall be made as to missing measurements and in case there are any missing items or measurements the same shall be recorded.
- 34.** The Contractor shall not directly or indirectly transfer, assign or sublet the Contract or any part of it, without written permission of NABARD.
- 35.** Any defect which may appear within the **Defect Liability Period** after the **Virtual completion of work (Annexure-C)** should be rectified by the Contractor at his cost. The Contractor will have to execute a **Performance Undertaking (Annexure-B)** on non-judicial stamp paper after the virtual completion of work.
- 36. Defects Liability Period:** Five years from the date of Virtual Completion of works certified by NABARD.
- 37. Validity of Tender Rates:** Validity of the quoted rates shall be 3 months from the date of opening of price bid.
- 38. Liquidated Damages:** The quantum of liquidated damages per week shall be calculated at 0.25% of the estimated cost subject to a maximum of 5% of the accepted tender amount.
- 39. Dispute Resolution:**
- In the event of any differences of opinion or dispute the matter will be referred to GM/OIC, NABARD, New Delhi Regional Office and his decision will be final.

2. 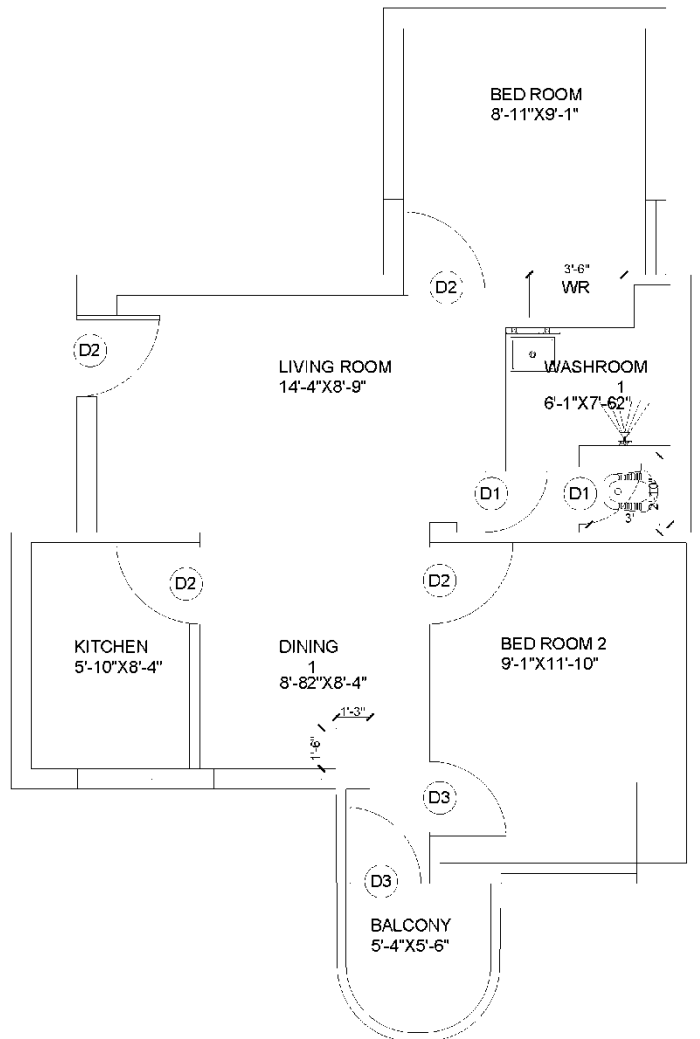
