

his is NABARD's goal through its Self-help group (SHG). banking program, leveraging the strength of the formal banking system and the flexibility of informal self-help groups in providing adequate financial services to the rural poor. Through NGOs, government agencies and banks, vast numbers of self-help groups have been established in recent years: as selfreliant autonomous local financial intermediaries, 90% of the members are women; they have proven to be the better savers, borrowers and investors. Most of them are from the lowest castes and other disadvantaged groups. The SHGs mobilize their own savings, transform them into loans to members and plow their earnings from interest income back into equity. On that basis, SHGs and banks enter into commercial relations of mutual benefit, with low bank and client transaction costs and negligible risks. In the absence of interest rate restrictions and with repayment rates >99%, SHG banking is highly profitable - a message that has convinced hesitant bank managers in increasing numbers. SHGs are now forming local networks with their own cooperative financial institutions. The program has turned into a social movement, with high expansion rates in recent years. Fuelled by competence and enthusiasm at all stakeholder levels, it expands rapidly throughout India, including marginal and tribal areas. It is probably the world's largest and most successful microfinance program for the rural poor -outstanding in its emphasis on self-reliance and local autonomy of the very poor.

NABARD is now facing the combined challenges of how to disseminate the approach throughout India and the region; and how to continue financing the incremental costs of technical and financial assistance to the participating Agencies.

microFinance Uptrends



- The synergy between banks, NGOs and government working in the field
 of microFinance enabled the banking system to provide microCredit
 to 4.5 m. very poor households as at March 2001, as compared to 1.9 m.
 households as at March 2000.
- The participation of banking sector in microFinance increased to unprecedented levels during the last year. Between 1999-00 and 2000-01, ground level flow of microCredit to SHGs from the banking sector increased by 113 percent.
- The on time repayment performance of SHG loans continued to be above 95 percent. The coverage of women members through SHG loans increased to over 90 percent.
- The showcasing of microFinance products as profitable business proposition by many banks in the commercial, regional rural and cooperative banking fields has firmly put microFinance on the road to mainstream banking in the country.
- The setting up of microFinance Development Fund by the banking system marks an important step. Pursuant to the announcement of the Union Finance Minister in his budget speech for the year 2000-01, this Fund has been started with a start up contribution of Rs. 1,000 m.. RBI and NABARD have already contributed Rs. 400 m. each to the Fund. Some selected commercial banks like Andhra Bank, Bank of Baroda, Oriental Bank of Commerce and Bank of Maharashtra have contributed to the Fund. Some other banks are also contributing. In addition to the initial amount, NABARD has contributed an additional amount of Rs. 50 m. to the Fund. The Fund has been created to
 - Support capacity building and exposure to SHG members, partner NGOs, banks and government agencies
 - Provide start up funds to mF institutions (mFIs) and to meet their initial operational deficits
 - Meet the cost of formation and nurturing of SHGs
 - Provide entrepreneurial skill development to socially disadvantaged classes
 - * Promote research, action research, management information systems and dissemination of best practices in mF.





SHG-bank Linkage Programme – 2000-01 DETAILS

The number of new SHGs accessing mircoCredit from banks during 2000-01 increased to 149,050 from 81,780 during 1999-00 (82%) growth during 2000-01). As at March 2001, the number of SHGs accessing microCredit from banks reached 263,825, as compared with 114,775 SHGs as at March 2000 (130% cumulative growth as at March 2001). This was made possible by the synergy that developed out of close cooperation and coordination between different field level partners in microFinance, viz., banks, NGOs, and government agencies. The number of NGOs and other Self-Help Group Promoting Institutions (SHPIs) participating in the programme during the year increased to 1,030, as against 718 institutions during the previous year. More than 15,000 branches of 314 banks were involved in credit-linking of SHGs. The policy support extended by GOI and RBI and various initiatives taken by NABARD including capacity building of partner agencies contributed to the success of the programme.

* State-wise outreach

The SHG-bank linkage programme covered 412 districts in 25 states and 2 UTs of the country. Andhra Pradesh remained in the forefront with 77,855 SHGs financed during 2000-01, followed by Tamil Nadu (19,032), Uttar Pradesh (10,199), Karnataka (8,009), Maharashtra (5,509), West Bengal (5,342) Orissa (4,820), and Kerala (4,074). Some of the other states which recorded significant increase in SHG-bank linkage during the year were Rajasthan (3,675) and Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh (3,396). Details of physical and financial progress as at March 2001 are presented in Statement III².

* Regional Spread

Despite good progress in other regions, the Southern region continued to lead the other regions in the performance under SHG-bank linkage programme. It's share in the total achievement increased from 67% during 1999-00 to 73% during 2000-01. There was a decrease in the share of Central region from 13% to 9%. The Eastern and Western regions also slipped marginally by 1% and 2% respectively, whereas the Northern region showed a marginal rise of 1% as compared with the previous year. The SHG bank linkage programme has not registered any headway in the North Eastern Region, which still accounts for less than 1 percent of the programme. In order to address the deficiencies arising from poor banking network and resultant credit flow, NABARD has been encouraging different NGOs in the Region to undertake formation, nurturing and financial

By the time of writing this report, the entire disaggregated data could not be compiled. Therefore, some of the disaggregated data presented and analysed here is limited to SHGs where credit linkage by banks was supported with refinance assistance from NABARD. Considering that more than 90 percent of credit linked SHGs have been supported with refinance from NABARD, the trends available are likely to hold true for the entire population.

intermediation roles in the North Eastern Region. Special state specific initiatives for reaching the very poor in the Region are being taken.

NABARD has been paying special attention to the backward areas of Kalahandi-Bolangir-Koraput (KBK region) in Orissa. As a strategy, NABARD is encouraging collboration with large number of small NGO-partners and mF agencies for enhancing the coverage of poor rural households through SHG-bank linkage. These efforts have resulted in increasing the number of SHGs credit linked to banks in the KBK Region to 2,767 during 2000-2001 from 899 during the previous year.

★ Different Models of Linkage

* Model I: SHGs formed and financed by banks

Under this model, banks themselves act as Self Help Promoting Institutions i.e. forming and nurturing the groups, opening their savings accounts and providing them bank loans. As at March 2001, 13% of the total number of SHGs financed were from this category. After introduction of the 'Low Cost Module' of assistance from NABARD and making it applicable in all states during the ensuing year, it is expected that many more branches of RRBs would be involved in promotion and financing of SHGs in the coming years.

* Model II: SHGs formed by NGOs and formal agencies, but directly financed by banks

This appears to be the most popular model amongst bankers. Under this model NGOs and formal agencies in the field of microFinance act as facilitators. They propagate the message, organise groups, train them in thrift and credit management and nurture them over a period. Banks, in due course, link these groups by directly providing loans to them. Major share of SHGs linked as at March 2001(76%) is under this model as compared to 70% as at March 2000. This increase is in tune with the increase in partner NGOs and other SHPIs during the year.

* Model III: SHGs financed by banks using NGOs as financial intermediaries

In this model, NGOs take on the dual role of facilitators and financial intermediaries. They help in formation of SHGs, nurturing them, training them in thrift and credit management. Eventually, the NGOs approach banks for bulk loan assistance for on lending to these SHGs. The share of cumulative number of SHGs linked under this model is relatively small i.e. 11%. However, in the years to come, a need may arise for the SHGs as also for lending institutions

to look for viable sub structures for financial intermediation. This could eventually develop into an effective method to control transaction costs through economies of scale.

* Commercial Banks

All the 27 public sector banks and 16 private sector banks participated in the SHG-bank linkage programme. Refinance support was available from NABARD to these banks against their loans to SHGs.

During the year, Andhra Bank credit linked the highest number of SHGs (17,358), followed by State Bank of India (17,105) and State Bank of Hyderabad (6,273). The other banks which had a significant share in the SHG-linkage programme were Indian Overseas Bank, Indian Bank, Canara Bank, Bank of India and Bank of Baroda. Private sector commercial banks which provided loans to SHGs in significant numbers during the year 2000-01 were Vysya Bank (918) Global Trust Bank (604) and Bank of Madura (363).

The State-wise and bank-wise position of SHG-bank linkage is presented in Statement – VI.

* Regional Rural Banks (RRBs)3

Out of total 196 RRBs in the country, 177 participated in the SHG-bank linkage programme (i.e. more than 90%). RRBs' share in the total cumulative achievement has shown an increase in terms of SHGs linked, bank loan disbursed and refinance availed from NABARD. During the year, maximum number of SHGs have been linked by Shri Visakha GB in Andhra Pradesh (7,339), followed by Nagarjuna GB (4,802) in AP, Pandiyan GB in Tamil Nadu (4,155), and Manjira GB (2,189) in AP. The other RRBs showing significant achievement are Kalahandi GB in Orissa, Vallalar GB in TN, Cauvery and Sahyadri GBs in Karnataka, North and South Malabar GBs in

PRBs are popularly called Gramin (meaning rural) Banks or GBs in local parlance. They are scheduled commercial banks which operate in a limited number of districts.



Kerala, Kanpur and Raebareli GBs in UP.

The state-wise and RRB-wise number of SHGs linked is presented in Statement – VII.

* Cooperatives

94 cooperatives at the district and village levels in 18 states and UTs have participated in the programme as at March 2001. They shared 5% of the total number of SHGs credit linked. In many of the states suitable amendments in the Cooperative Societies Act have now been made enabling the SHGs to become members of PACS and avail loans. State-wise, cooperative bank wise linkage of SHGs is furnished in Statement – VIII.

★ Self Help Promoting Institutions (SHPIs)

* RRBs functioning as SHPI

NABARD has been providing assistance to willing RRBs to function as SHPIs. As at March 2001, 13 RRBs in 5 states were supported under this programme with grant assistance of Rs. 5.1m. for building up their capacities and increasing their mobility to facilitate promotion and linkage of 4,550 SHGs. As at March 2001, over 3,794 SHGs were promoted by them of which 2,121 were linked with bank credit. Further, under a new low cost module developed by NABARD, 22 RRBs in 7 states were sanctioned grant assistance of Rs. 3.5 m. for promotion of 6,900 SHGs.

* NGOs as SHPIs

The total number of NGOs participating in the SHG promotion and linkage has increased from 718 last year to 1,030 as at March 2001. The NGOs are involved either as facilitators, playing a catalytic role in formation of SHGs and nurturing them in the initial period or as financial intermediators, i.e., providing loan assistance to SHGs and individuals till they are formally linked with banks. In order to widen the scope for SHG formation, NABARD encourages small NGOs to take SHG promotion and linkage as an add-on activity. Apart from support for training and capacity building of NGO staff, financial assistance is extended in the form of promotional grant for formation and nurturing of SHGs by NGOs which act as SHPIs. NABARD also organises various types of exposure and awareness programmes for CEOs and field level functionaries of these NGOs. During the year 2000-01 NABARD sanctioned grant assistance of

Rs.21 m. to 126 NGOs for promotion and linkage of over 20,000 SHGs. The cumulative amount of grant sanctioned as at March 2001 aggregated Rs. 46 m. covering 198 NGOs for promotion and linkage of around 37,000 SHGs.

* Farmers' Clubs as SHPIs

NABARD has been encouraging informal forums called Farmers' Clubs under the Vikas Volunteer Vahini (VVV) Programme. The Farmers' Clubs formed by bank branches under the VVV Programme spread the message of 'development through credit' and inculcate repayment ethics among borrowers. These clubs have already gained local acceptability and have good potential to work as SHPIs. A module has been developed by NABARD for supporting these farmers' clubs to efficiently function as SHPIs. An amount of Rs.5.5 m. was sanctioned to 515 VVV clubs to promote 5,150 SHGs.

* Individual Volunteers promoting SHGs

As part of its strategy to popularise mF initiatives in backward states and districts which lack institutional framework and appropriate NGOs in adequate numbers, NABARD has decided to evaluate the efficacy of harnessing voluntary initiatives of socially committed rural individuals for organising rural poor into SHGs. A pilot model for the purpose is being operationalised through select RRBs and DCCBs in backward districts in some of the states like Orissa, UP, MP, Bihar and Rajasthan.

* Revolving Fund Assistance (RFA) to NGOs

NABARD has been providing Revolving Fund Assistance (RFA) on a selective basis to NGOs, SHG Federations and Credit Unions for on-lending to SHGs and individuals. NABARD has also been extending support to NGO networks for providing financial assistance to smaller NGOs for building their financial intermediation capacity. During the year 2000-01, RFA of Rs.10 m. was sanctioned to FWWB, Ahmedabad for networking of smaller NGOs taking the aggregate sanction of RFA to Rs.122.2 m. covering 24 agencies. An amount of Rs.12 m. was disbursed during the year 2000-01 taking the cumulative disbursement to Rs.71 m. to 21 agencies as at March 2001.

★ Capacity building of partner institutions

As a part of the strategy for building up human capital among its partner agencies, NABARD reviews and reorients its capacity building efforts on an ongoing basis. A consultation meet on training strategy organised by NABARD at Lucknow reviewed and modified the existing training modules for bankers, NGOs and government officials. It also considered development of separate training modules for training of trainers. During the year various training programmes were organised, suiting the requirements of different partners viz. bankers, NGOs, trainers (from training establishments of banks and NGOs),

* Training of SHGs

With a view to dovetailing group dynamics and financial resources, capacity building programmes for SHG members and their leaders



were organised by different ROs of NABARD in association with identified Resource NGOs. During the year 2000-01 2,191 such programmes covering 1,35,226 members of different SHGs were organised throughout the country. This is in addition to regular capacity building efforts by SHPIs.

* Training of Bankers

513 Training programmes specially designed for bankers benefiting over 16,900 officials of various banks including Chairmen of RRBs and middle and senior level officials of commercial banks and cooperative banks were conducted in different parts of the country. Trainers' training was provided to 139 faculty members of training colleges of various commercial banks through 8 programmes, to equip them to handle training programmes on the SHG concept in their own training establishments.

* Training of NGOs

During the year, refresher programmes and awareness programmes were conducted for CEOs and field programmes for the grassroots level functionaries of different NGOs. In all 144 such programmes were conducted during the year, benefiting 4,158 participants.

* Training of Banks as SHPIs

Training and awareness programmes were organised for banks to act as SHPIs , to equip them to effectively form and nurture SHGs. These programmes were conducted by ROs of NABARD in association with Resource NGOs. During the year, 9 such programmes covering about 179 participants were conducted in different parts of the country.

* Training for Government officials

More than 100 exposure programmes on microFinance for around 4,500 government officers were conducted by NABARD during the year at different training establishments, including the Centre for Cooperatives and Rural Development (CCRD) of Lal Bahadur Shastry National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie. An exclusive programme on microFinance and SHGs was conducted during the year for 22 IAS officers drawn from 10 different state cadres.

* Training of NABARD Officials

During the year, NABARD conducted nine residential and location specific training programmes for its own officers functioning as DDMs, DDOs, Nominee Directors on the Board of RRBs, and officers from MCI Cells in various ROs. These programmes covered 205 officers. With this, a total of 709 officers of NABARD have so far been trained in such special programmes.

A summary of training programmes under bank linkage may be seen at Annexure I. Details of capacity building programmes supported by NABARD for different agencies may be seen at Annexure II.

* Linking with Future

The SHG-bank linkage programmes is now at the threshold of transforming itself into a movement, making it possible for at least 100 m. rural poor to access formal financial services by 2008.



Recognising the power of the social capital generated out of the SHG programme, Minister for Rural Development, Government of India, has exhorted state governments, banks, NGOs and other development partners to give the dimensions of a national movement to the SHG programme. The challenge is to transform this into a reality, by ensuring the spread of the programme to even the most backward states and districts of the country. The commercial aspects of SHG- bank linkage have started getting showcased in areas where sizable number of SHGs have been credit linked. Therefore, the future course is to facilitate internalisation of banking with the poor through SHGs as a regular financial product of the banking system rather than its continuing as a programme.

The broad contours of the expansion strategy would be

- Accelerating awareness building and training of new partners in the areas not yet reached.
- Supporting banks to take on the role of SHPIs. Already, all RRBs are elgible for support from NABARD, to act as SHPIs.
- Encouraging banks to build partnerships with varying SHPIs
- Encouraging small NGOs active in different fields viz., literacy, health care etc. to take SHG promotion and their bank linkage as an add-on activity
- Providing support to federations of SHGs
- Need-based training support to bank and NGO personnel

- Documenting best practices and disseminating them
- Encouraging participation of cooperatives in the SHG linkage programme
- Reaching cost-effective and sustainable insurance products to the poor clientele, to reduce their vulnerability to unforeseen risks
