



**“Management of Ecosystem of Kaziranga National Park by Creating Climate Resilient Livelihood for Vulnerable Communities through Organic farming and Pond Based Pisciculture :** The project aims to rejuvenate available surface water bodies to develop fisheries, practice climate resilient agriculture and to create opportunities for vulnerable communities to adapt to impacts of climate change through project interventions aimed towards increasing livelihood avenues like organic farming, watershed management and capacity building. The project would cover Gorpāl and Tewaripāl villages of North Bank and Kaziranga Hukuma, Kunjuri-Gelabeel, Amguri Chang and Phulaguri Chang, Japori Beel villages of South Bank. Kaziranga National Park (KNP) under Department of Environment & Forests (DoE&F), Government of Assam is executing the project with an outlay of Rs. 24.57 Crores.
