"Climate Adaptation Strategies in Wetlands along Mahanadi River Catchment areas in Chhattisgarh" aims to facilitate the long term restoration and management of wetlands through promotion of sustainable agriculture, water conservation and demand management, resource harvesting, livelihood diversification, community participation, JFM initiatives. The project covering 20,000 ha. is under implementation in Mahasamund (6,000 ha.), Baloda Bazar (6,000 ha.) and Dhamtari (8,000 ha) districts of Chhattisgarh having substantial wetland cover. The project is being executed by State Centre for Climate Change, Government of Chhattisgarh with an outlay of Rs. 21.47 Crores.
