The project is being executed by Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Government of Karnataka with an outlay of Rs. 24.22 Crores in Dakshina Kannada, Bidar and Tumakuru for cattle related interventions and Mandya, Belagavi, Haveri for sheep related interventions and Bellary and Tumakuru for fodder development.
