



Promotion of Integrated Farming System of Kaipad and Pokkali in coastal wetlands of Kerala”: The objective of the project is to promote integrated farming system in Pokkali and Kaipad where saline tolerant paddy is cultivated along with integration of fishery as an opportunity to upscale climate resilient farming practices, ensure food security, and promote livelihood generation opportunities. The project would be executed in 600 hectares (300 hectares of Kaipad land from Kannur District and 300 hectares of Pokkali land from Ernakulam, Thrissur and Alappuzha districts) by Agency for Development of Aquaculture (ADAK), Government of Kerala with an outlay of Rs. 25 Crores.
