

“Addressing Climate Change Vulnerability of Water Sector at Gram Panchayat level in Drought prone areas of Sikkim”

This project aims to address the issue of water security through baseline assessment, preparation of village water security plan, community mobilization, training programs, recharge of mountain springs, roof top water harvesting, etc. which are directly identified as climate resilience building interventions under SAPCC for Sikkim. The project is being implemented in 74 Gram Panchayats in 12 blocks of South and West Sikkim. The project would cover around 1.85 lakh beneficiaries from South and West Districts of Sikkim. Rural Management and Development Department, Government of Sikkim is executing the project with an outlay of Rs. 24.67 Crores.
