



“Climate Resilient Interventions in Dairy Sector in Coastal and Arid Areas in Andhra Pradesh” is being executed in six climatically vulnerable mandals namely Pamidi, Dharmavaram, Allur, Podalkur, Gantayada and Badangi located in three districts viz., Anantapur, Nellore and Vizianagaram districts of Andhra Pradesh. The proposed project adopts an integrated and ecosystem-based approach for enhancing the adaptive capacities of small and marginal farmers dependent on dairy sector in drought and cyclone prone areas of Andhra Pradesh in the light of climate change. The project would benefit 5000 small and marginal farmers and 25 unemployed youth (as potential entrepreneurs). Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Andhra Pradesh is executing the project with an outlay of Rs. 11.53 Crores.
