

Long Term Irrigation Fund (LTIF) - long term benefits for Indian irrigation

The 2016-17 Union Budget made a path breaking announcement in the sector of irrigation - setting up of Long Term Irrigation Fund (LTIF) in NABARD with an initial corpus of Rs 20,000 crore for funding of irrigation projects which were languishing for want of funds for many years.

Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, RD & GR), Government of India obtained Cabinet approval on 27 July 2016, for funding of 99 projects identified under LTIF. The overall estimated financial requirement towards Central Assistance and State Share has been assessed as Rs.77,908 crore (Central Share – Rs.31,342 cr and Rs.313 cr for concurrent evaluation, social audit etc ; State Share – Rs.46,253 cr) over 4 years i.e. up to December 2019.

In addition to the identified 99 irrigation projects, Polavaram National Project from Andhra Pradesh and North Koel Reservoir Project from Bihar & Jharkhand have been included for funding under LTIF.

The likely Irrigation Potential (IP) of 79.48 lakh Ha. (including IP of 2.91 lakh Ha. & 0.40 lakh Ha. in respect of Polavaram & North Koel Reservoir projects respectively) would be created on completion of these projects.

The details of loan amount sanctioned and released towards Central & State Share for Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) and Command Area Development & Water Management (CADWM) component-wise, as on 30th June 2018 are as under:
