However, payment will be released as per the minimum wages as amended from time to time by central govt. or state govt., whichever is higher. Deduction on account of absenteeism/ day will be worked out by dividing the total wage of that month by the no. days of the month.

## Annexure E

### Procedure to find out the %age rate for tank cleaning in Tender for Annual Maintenance Contract for housekeeping work for NABARD, Jharkhand Regional Office and Officers' Quarters, Ranchi:

Example:

**A** = total volume of tanks =  $(27 \text{ m}^3 + 27 \text{ m}^3 + 285 \text{ m}^3) = 339 \text{ m}^3$

**B** = The cost of cleaning of tanks with total volume of  $339 \text{ m}^3$   
= Rs. 17000 (*assumption*)

**C** = The cost of tank cleaning per  $\text{m}^3 = B/A = 17000/339$   
= Rs. 50.147 per  $\text{m}^3$

**D** = The cost of Cleaning Material per day  
= Rs. 400 (*assumption*)

Let's say,

**E** = Total minimum wages including PF and ESI per month (excluding GST)  
= Rs. 1,75,000/- (*assumption*)

**F** = Rate of tank cleaning per  $\text{m}^3$  as a %age of E  
=  $(C/E) \times 100 = (50.147/1,75,000) \times 100$   
= 0.03 %

**G** = Rate of Cleaning Material as a %age of E  
=  $(D/E) \times 100 = (400/1,75,000) \times 100$   
= 0.23 %

Let's say, **H** = Service charge quoted by Bidder = 4.25 % (*assumption*)

Value of (F + G + H) shall be indicated in GeM portal in respect of Service charge.

In above example, the bidder will quote  $(0.03 + 0.23 + 4.25) = 4.51$  % as service charge in GeM portal.

**Procedure to find out the %age rate for tank cleaning for Annual Maintenance Contract for Civil, Plumbing, Carpentry and Electrical maintenance works for Office Building and Officers' Quarters of NABARD, Ranchi:**

Example:

**A** = total volume of tanks =  $(27 \text{ m}^3 + 27 \text{ m}^3 + 285 \text{ m}^3) = 339 \text{ m}^3$

**B** = The cost of cleaning of tanks with total volume of  $339 \text{ m}^3$   
= Rs. 17000 (*assumption*)

**C** = The cost of tank cleaning per  $\text{m}^3 = B/A = 17000/339 = \text{Rs. } 50.147 \text{ per m}^3$

Let's say,

**D** = Total minimum wages per month including PF and ESI (excluding GST) is  
= Rs. 1,25,000/- (*assumption*)

**E** = Rate of tank cleaning per  $\text{m}^3$  as a %age of D  
=  $(C/D) \times 100 = (50.147/1,25,000) \times 100$   
= 0.04 %

Let's say, **F** = Service charge quoted by Bidder = 4.25 % (*assumption*)

Value of (E + F) shall be indicated in GeM portal in respect of Service charge.  
In above example, the bidder will quote  $(0.04 + 4.25) = 4.29$  % as service charge in GeM portal.



## Annexure G

### Illustration for filling service charges in GeM Portal regarding AMC Caretaking services of VOF at Block 20, Sector 01, National Games Housing Complex, Khelgaon:

The bidders are required to go through the following instructions while quoting the rates:

- Normal Staff** – One skilled and Two unskilled who will work permanently throughout the month except in their off days.
  - Substitute Staff** – The staff who will work only on the off days of the Normal Staff.
- The bidders are required to go through the revised menu base rate chart (**Annexure H**). The bidders may indicate the menu rate more or less than the base rate as per their assessment.
- The procedure to find out the L1 bidder is as under:

#### Example:

Menu rate:      **A** = Total cost of Group A items = Rs.1000/- (assumption)  
                         **B** = Total cost of Group B items = Rs. 4500/- (assumption)

**C** = Total cost of all menu items  
= {A x (30/100)} + {B x (70/100)}  
= {1000 x (30/100)} + {4500 x (70/100)}  
= 300 + 3150  
= 3450

**D** = Total amount per annum quoted in Price bid  
= Rs. 11,00,000/- (assumption)

**E** = Rate of all menu items as a % of D  
= (C/D) x 100 = (3450/11,00,000) x 100  
= 0.31 %

Let's say, **F** = Service charge quoted by Bidder = 4.25 % (assumption)

Value of (E + F) shall be indicated in GeM portal in respect of Service charge.  
i.e. in above example, the bidder will quote (0.31+4.25) = **4.56 % as service charge in GeM portal.**

## Annexure H

The Visiting Officers' Flat (VOF) guests and other NABARD officials shall be served with the following hygienically cooked food items, which shall be of excellent quality and sufficient quantity to satisfy the guests. The contractor shall recover the food charges from the guests at a rate not more than the rates mentioned in the Rate Chart, which may be revised annually as per mutual agreement of NABARD and the contractor. The cost of food charge will also include the cost of cooking gas.

**Selection Process:** The list of menu item in two Groups (Group A & Group B) indicated below. Bidders are required to quote rates against each and every item below. Weightage for Group A & Group B items is fixed at ratio of 30:70. The combined rate quoted for manpower and menu items will be considered for finalisation of tender and award of work as per procedure mentioned in Annexure G.
