Sealed Tenders are invited from intending local, resourceful and experienced tenderers / bidders with sound technical and financial capabilities under 'Single Bid System' for the work of "Providing, Supplying and Laying Bituminous Bound Macadam (BBM) of Premix / Readymix through Paver Finisher Machine for Recarpeting Internal Road of Residential Colony at NABARD Vihar, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad" which is to be completed **within 14 days** from the date of issuing the work order.

2. Contractors /firms having minimum 5 years of experience in similar type of civil works are eligible to quote/ tender for the captioned work. Further, the contractors /firms should have done at least 03 similar works whose value is not less than Rs. 3.00 lakh each or 02 similar works whose value is not less than Rs. 3.75 lakh each or 01 similar work whose value is not less than Rs. 6.00 lakh and who are registered with the Government/Semi-Government Undertakings/Financial Institutions (GoI/State Govt.) can tender for the work.

3. Tender shall accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.12,000/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand only) by way of Demand Draft (DD) in favor of 'NABARD' drawn on any Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank payable at Ahmedabad OR fund transfer through NEFT/RTGS to NABARD's Current Account No.912020012465660 with Axis Bank Ltd., Navrangpura Branch, Ahmedabad. IFS Code: UTIB0001336 (underlined figures to be read as zero) and documentary evidence of deposit in the form of UTR / Receipt Voucher is to be enclosed along with the duly filled, signed & complete in all respects Tender document. Tender without EMD shall be rejected.

4. The tenderer / bidder is advised to visit the site and examine the site condition where the work is proposed to be carried out and to get himself fully acquainted at his own responsibility for all information that may be necessary for quoting the tender bid and entering in to contract. All cost and liabilities arising out of the site visit shall be at

tenderer / bidder account. Once the tender is submitted, it will not be allowed to be revised.

5. Captioned work to be executed as per plan, scope of work, specification and schedule of quantity under consultation with the Bank's Engineer-in- Charge (EIC).

6. Tender forms with terms and conditions can be downloaded from NABARD website (<https://www.nabard.org/Tenders.aspx?cid=501&id=24>). The tender will be considered/accepted from those agencies who furnish written information about the name and address of their bankers and clients with name of works, year/s of execution, cost and the authority under whom it was executed along with their correct postal address and other requirements etc. with documentary evidence.

7. Tenderer can submit their bids complete in all respect under 'Single Bid System' in a single envelope, super scribing the name of the captioned work and addressed to "The Chief General Manager, NABARD Gujarat RO, NABARD Towers, Opposite- Municipal Garden, Usmanpura, Ahmedabad 380013" which will be received by the Bank upto 3.00 PM on 18 June 2019 and preferably, shall be opened on the same day at 3.30 PM in the presence of authorized representatives of bidders/tenderers, who choose to be present or in any eventuality, at the convenient day and time fixed by the Bank.

NABARD Gujarat RO, Ahmedabad reserves right to change/modify/amend any or all provisions of the tender document and also reserves the right to reject any or all offers or to accept the offer in whole or in part without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof. PART-I

Technical Specification and Scope of Work

Technical Specifications

The specifications for the entire work under the Contract shall be in accordance with the latest "CPWD Specifications", Indian Road Congress Standard Specifications and Codes of Practice as per latest "Indian Standard Codes (ISC)". Wherever these codes are silent, the same shall be governed by sound Engineering practice, and the decision of the "Engineer-in-Charge [EIC]" of NABARD, in matter of interpretation, shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

The bidder must read carefully all such specifications/codes before submitting their bid. It shall be deemed that the Bidder has thoroughly read & understood "Specifications & Scope of Work" before filling in the rates/prices, irrespective of the fact whether they have really done so or not, and no claim on this account shall be entertained at a later date.

Scope of Work

The scope of work shall be generally as per Schedule of Rates, drawings etc. for the subject work which are self-explanatory but not limited to the quantities and specifications indicated therein. However, it is understood that the scope of work shall include inter alia, the carrying out of any and all works and providing any and all facilities, as required for completing the works as per terms and conditions of Contract Document. The captioned work preferably to be undertaken post 10:00 PM to ensure minimal disturbance to the residents. Tenderers / Bidders are advised to quote the rates accordingly.

The work includes tools, equipment, men, material and machine etc. as required for the execution and completion of the job in all aspect as per contract specifications. Contractor's scope of work shall include but not limited to the following:-

Repairs, Cleaning, Surface Dressing and Preparation of Surface

Manholes /Pot holes or patches and ruts on the surface course which is to be surface treated, shall be repaired by removal of all loose and defective material appropriately and replacement with suitable material. Thereafter surface shall be exposed up / scratched to a depth of about 10 mm by means of wire brushes / scratching machine etc. The surface shall then be brushed with soft brooms to remove all loose aggregate. Finally the traces of fine dust which get accumulated while brushing shall be thoroughly removed from the surface using high compressor blower.

Prior to the application of tack coat bitumen, all vegetation, loose sealing compound, caked mud, dust, dirt, dry leaves and foreign materials etc. shall be removed from the entire surface of the existing road, pavements and from constructions and expansion joints (wherever existing) by means of mechanical sweepers and high-powered air compressor/ blowers otherwise with steel wire brushes, small picks, brooms or other implements as approved by the Engineer-in-Charge. The material so removed shall be disposed off as

directed by the Engineer-in- Charge. The tack coat shall not be applied nor any bitumen work done when the surface is damp or wet.

Applying of Tack Coat of Hot Straight Run Bitumen

Providing and applying tack coat using hot straight run bitumen of appropriate grade as per Code of practice conforming to relevant ISC including heating the bitumen, spraying the bitumen with mechanically operated spray unit fitted on bitumen boiler, cleaning and preparing the existing road surface as per specifications. Bitumen shall be heated in a mechanized mobile boiler to the required temperature and maintained at that temperature. Hot bitumen shall be applied evenly to the clean, dry surface by means of a pressure sprayer at specified rate. Even and uniform distribution of bitumen shall be ensured. Excessive deposits of bitumen caused by stopping or starting of the sprayer or through leakage or any other reason shall be suitably rectified.

Providing and Laying of uniform 40mm Thick Premix / Readymix Carpet through Paver Finisher Machine

After application of tack coat as above indicated, required quantity of premix material containing fine stone chippings (8-10 mm) mixed with the bitumen binder of approved grade sourced / transported by tippers or suitable vehicles from nearby / premix / readymix plants to the point of use, shall be laid to the uniform thickness of about 40 mm by paver finisher machine.

Spreading of Premix with Paver Finisher Machine and Rolling with Vibratory Roller / Compactor

The premixed material shall be spread on the road surface through paver finisher machine. While laying the premix material through paver, the camber should be adjusted proportionately and of appropriate degree suitable to the dimension of both side of the road. After laying and spreading the premix material (BBM), rolling shall commence with at least 9 tonne power vibratory roller / compactor for even and smooth surface. Rolling shall begin at the edges and progress towards the centre longitudinally. Except on the super elevated portions rolling shall progress from the lower to upper edge, parallel to the centre line of the pavement. The consolidated thickness shall not at any place be less than the specified thickness by more than 25%. However, the average thickness shall not be less than that specified in the item.

When the roller has passed over the whole area once, any high spots or depressions which become apparent shall be corrected by removing or adding premixed materials. Rolling shall then be continued until the entire surface has been rolled to compaction and all the roller marks eliminated. In each pass of the roller, preceding track shall be overlapped uniformly by at least 1/3 width. The roller wheels shall be kept damp to prevent the premix from adhering to the wheels and being picked up. In no case shall fuel/lubricating oil be used for this purpose. Rollers shall not stand on newly laid material as it may get deformed thereby.

Rectification

Where the surface uneven/ irregularly fall outside the specified tolerances the contractor shall be liable to rectify it to the satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge by adding fresh material and re-compacting to specifications where the surface is low. Where the surface is high the full depth of the layer shall be removed and replaced with fresh material and compacted to specifications.

Surface Finishing through Providing and Applying Seal Coat

This work shall consist of the application of a seal coat for sealing the voids in a bituminous surface laid to the specified levels, grade and cross fall (camber). Providing and laying seal coat of premixed fine aggregate with bitumen using adequate quantity of bitumen of appropriate grade including rolling and finishing with vibratory road roller / compactor, all complete.

As soon as a sufficient length has been covered with the premixed material, the surface shall be rolled with at least 9 tonne (or above) smooth-wheeled vibratory roller / compactor. Rolling shall be continued until the premixed material completely seals the voids in the bituminous course and a smooth uniform surface is obtained. Further, the prepared finished surface shall be protected from traffic for such period as may be directed by the Engineer-in-Charge.

Providing and Applying of Road Safety Marking Strips, Signs

After applying of final seal coat for smooth surface, following the Road Safety Rules, Contractor shall arrange to mark reflective thermoplastic paint strip to give uniform finish with ready mixed road marking paint conforming to IRC: 35-1997 applied both edges of the road using thermoplastic road marking machine on bituminous surface in white shade, including cleaning the surface of all dirt, scales, oil, grease and foreign material etc., complete.

Further, 5 nos. mandatory / cautionary road sign posts (IRC:67-2012) applicable to the site to be installed as well as at least 4 solar powered signal LED posts (Red & Yellow) to be fixed at appropriate places alongside the road. In addition, approx. 150 double edged solar powered reflective cats eyes (Red & Yellow) to be fixed at equal distance over the reflective thermoplastic markings.

Measurement and Rates

After completion of work, final length and breadth shall be measured in meter alongside the pavement. Area shall be worked out in Square Meters (Sqm) correct to two decimal places. Rate shall include the cost of all machine, materials and labour etc. involved in all the operations described above including rate for reflective thermoplastic road markings strips, road safety signs, solar powered signal posts and cats eyes etc. inclusive of GST.

Testing and Inspection

The Contractor shall carry out the various tests as per CPWD/ IRC/ IS Specifications/

Standards as per requirements of work and instructions of EIC. No separate payment shall be made unless otherwise specified in schedule of rates.

Any work not conforming to Technical Specifications and Scope of Work, concerning CPWD specifications, Indian Road Congress Specifications and IS codes shall be rejected forthwith and the Contractor shall carryout the necessary rectification at his own cost.

All results of inspection and tests will be recorded in the inspection reports which will be approved by the Engineer-in-Charge. These reports shall form part of the completion documents.

General Terms and Conditions

Tenderer / Bidder is requested to read carefully the following and comply:

- 1) These Terms and Conditions are in addition to the instructions contained elsewhere in the tender documents.
- 2) Tenderers must have minimum five years of experience as on 31 March 2019 in works of similar nature. Preference will be given to the agencies having experience in the field of civil construction and maintenance of bituminous road works in Government departments, offices and staff quarters, housing societies etc.
- 3) Tenderers should have undertaken / completed following works in the last 5 years:

03 similar works, each of the value not less than Rs. 3.00 lakh
OR
02 similar works, each of the value not less than Rs. 3.75 lakh
OR
01 similar work of the value not less than Rs. 6.00 lakh
- 4) Complete Tender document alongwith EMD of specified amount should be submitted in a single envelope, clearly superscripted as “Providing, Supplying and Laying Bituminous Bound Macadam (BBM) of Premix / Readymix through Paver Finisher Machine for Recarpeting Internal Road of Residential Colony at NABARD Vihar, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad-380006” and addressed to “The Chief General Manager, NABARD Gujarat RO, NABARD Tower, Opposite- Municipal Garden, Usmanpura, Ahmedabad 380013”.
- 5) Tenders not accompanied with EMD or EMD not being in the requisite form shall not be considered and rejected. EMD of successful tenderer shall be retained and dealt as per the contract; while the EMD of unsuccessful tenderer shall be refunded without any interest within 30 days from the date from opening of tender.
- 6) In case acceptance of the bid, the successful bidders must enter into a contract agreement (Articles of Agreement) on non-judicial stamp paper, valuing Rs.100/- within seven days from the issue of work order.
- 7) Bidder must quote their rates inclusive of GST as per format of Schedule of Quantity.
- 8) Rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR) both in figures and in words (in English language only) in clear legible writing. No overwriting is allowed. All scoring and cancellations should be countersigned in full by the tenderer. In case of illegality / discrepancies, the interpretation of the Engineer-in Charge / Tender Committee shall be final.

- 9) CGM, NABARD reserves the right to approve/disapprove any kind of variation / change in the cost / scope of work and will be the sole arbitrator for all the disputes and his decision will be binding on both the parties.
- 10) Completion period will be 14 days from the date of issue of the work order.
- 11) The defect liability period shall be 12 months commencing from issue of completion certificate.
- 12) Incomplete, Conditional or Delayed Bids shall not be considered and summarily rejected.
- 13) The tenderer shall submit the original tender document duly signed and stamped on each paper as a token of acceptance of all terms and conditions and scope of work as specified.
- 14) Intended tenderer / bidder is advised to make a site visit before quoting for the tender to understand the scope and challenges of work.
- 15) Intended tenderer / bidder is advised to undertake the captioned work in the night shift, preferably after 10:00 PM onwards in the night to ensure minimal disturbance to the residents and smooth execution of work. Tenderer is advised to quote the item rates accordingly and complete the work as soon as possible.
- 16) All safety precautions are to be taken for execution of the work particularly for hot (bituminous related) works, etc. required for the road work.
- 17) The contractor shall have to abide by all SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS applicable for the works. This will include issue of security passes for all workers, provision of safety equipment, personal protective equipment etc. Safety equipment/ personal protective equipment will have to be provided by contractor at his own cost.
- 18) The rate should be inclusive of all overheads (men, machine, materials etc.) including GST as applicable.
- 19) The rate shall be firm till completion of work and no escalation on any account will be permitted.
- 20) The Contractor shall submit Solvency Certificate issued by any Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank of equal or more than the quoted value in the tender.
- 21) The Bank reserves the right to inspect the services of the vendor/contractor to verify the genuineness and to ensure the conformity with the details given in the bid.
- 22) During the execution of the work, any damage to the property of the complex/Bank is to be rectified as per the direction of the Bank's Engineer/official.

- 23) Entire Payment shall be made to the Contractor in one go (single & final bill settlement) as per the actual measurement at site for the quantity executed / specified material supplied/installed after satisfactory completion of the work and certification by the Bank's Engineer in this regard. Further, following deductions would be applicable from the eligible payment:
- (i) 5% of the total invoice amount as RMD (Retention Money Deposit) shall be retained by the Bank for a period of 12 months which shall be released after the completion of defect liability period. During defect liability period any defects pointed out by Bank may be carried out without any extra charge.
 - (ii) TDS as applicable will be deducted from the taxable value of the invoice while making payment.
 - (iii) GST-TDS as applicable will be deducted from the taxable value of the invoice while making payment.
- 24) CPWD/IRC specification should be followed wherever applicable.
- 25) The contractor shall make all required necessary arrangement at own cost for security of his materials at site till the work is completed in all respect and handed over to the Bank. The contractor shall clean and clear out all the unnecessary and unwanted items, debris, waste, garbage or material aggregates etc. generated while execution of work.
- 26) The contractor shall be responsible for all injury to person, animals or things and for all damage to property which may arise from the operation or neglect, carelessness, accident or any other cause whatever in any way connected with carrying out of the contract. The contractor shall indemnify the Employer (NABARD) and hold him harmless in respect of all and any expenses arising from any such injury or damage to persons or property as aforesaid.
- 27) Contractor should ensure the safety of his material at his risk and cost. NABARD will not be responsible for any type of damage or loss etc.
- 28) The contractor shall indemnify the employer against all claims which may be made against the Employer by any member of the public or other third party and shall maintain until the virtual completion of the contract, with an approved office a policy of Insurance in the joint names of the employer and the contractor against such risks and deposit such policy with the Employer during the currency of the contract.
- 29) Tenderer must fill the Letter of Indemnity and Undertaking (Annexure-IV) as well as Letter of Declaration as per proforma, complete in all manner.
- 30) If any damage is done to the Bank's property / installation by the Contractor's labourers, the same shall be recovered from the contractor. Therefore proper care

must be taken and experience / qualified persons should be deputed on the job to ensure safety of the man, machine and materials etc. The suitable penalty shall be imposed on any misconduct, default damages caused to NABARD due to negligence of the contractor.

- 31) The Contractor will be solely responsible and accountable to obtain all necessary NOCs, if any, related to before / after / during execution of said work on their expenses.
- 32) The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulations and Abolition) Act, 1970, Minimum Wages Act and all other Labour Laws and Statutory Regulations (both Central and State) including other Safety Rules etc. relevant Statutory provisions, as applicable, that may be enforced from time to time by the appropriate authorities.
- 33) Contractors are advised to visit the site before quoting the rates. In case of any dispute, the decision of NABARD shall be final and binding on the contractors.
- 34) The contractor shall at all times keep the site clean and shall dispose off all rubbish from time to time and also debris, waste, unnecessary and un-utilized materials etc. immediately after the completion of the work under the consultation with Engineer-in-Charge.
- 35) The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions in reducing pollution, if any, such as smoke, noise of dismantling, tools and tackles by means of mufflers, drills etc. work liable to create dust shall be well treated before being executed. The work shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the time schedule and other instructions given by the Engineer-in-Charge, taking care to cause minimum amount of noise, dust and other nuisance at the site. Daily cleaning of dirt, dust/debris, rubbish etc. has to be done after the day's work.
- 36) Force majeure conditions shall be applicable.
- 37) All disputes or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of relating to this contract or breach thereof shall be settled by the CGM, NABARD Gujarat RO, who will decide the dispute and whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 38) Any clarification on any of the points mentioned above, if required, may be obtained over phone (079-27554024) before submission of the tender/ bid.

AND WHEREAS the Tenderer has agreed to execute upon and subject to the conditions set forth in the Tender document and Conditions of Contract (all of which are collectively hereinafter referred to as "the said Conditions") the work shown upon the said technical specifications and the item-wise price (as per Schedule of Quantity) at the respective rates therein set forth amounting the sum as therein arrived or such other sum as shall become payable there under (hereinafter referred to as "the said contract amount").

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. In consideration hereinafter mentioned, the Tenderer will upon and subject to the conditions annexed, carry out and complete the supply/works shown in the contract, described by or referred to in the Schedule of Quantities and in the said conditions.
2. The Employer shall pay the Tenderer the said contract amount or such sum as shall become payable at the times and in the manner specified in the said conditions.
3. The said Conditions thereto and the documents attached hereto shall be read and construed as forming part of this Agreement and the parties hereto shall respectively abide by, submit themselves to the said Conditions and the correspondence and perform the agreements on their part respectively in the said conditions and the documents contained herein.
