

Vigilance Awareness Week (VAW) 2025 was observed from 27th October 2025 to 2nd November 2025 with the theme “**Vigilance: Our Shared Responsibility**”. During VAW 2025, following activities were organised by Central Vigilance Department (CVD):

- Walkathon was organized by NABARD at the Bandra-Kurla Complex on 28 October 2025. The event was flagged off by Shri Shaji K V, Chairman, NABARD, Shri G. S. Rawat and Dr. A.K. Sood, Deputy Managing Directors, NABARD, Shri B.S. Venkatesha, DMD, NaBFID and Shri U. Dinesh Shanbhag, Chief Vigilance Officer, NABARD. Ms. Minaxi Rawat, President, Vigilance Study Circle, Mumbai, Shri Hari Narayan Jangid, Secretary, Vigilance Study Circle, Shri S. Alagarsamy, CVO, General Insurance Corporation REA along with representatives from RCFL, NaBFID joined the walkathon. A spirited contingent of 950 participants carrying placards with slogans aligned with the theme, ensured dissemination of the message of “**Vigilance: Our Shared Responsibility**”. The event was widely covered by print media and social media.
- Senior Executives of NABARD administered the Integrity Pledge on 27 October 2025. Messages from the Hon’ble President, Vice President, Prime Minister, and the Central Vigilance Commission, Government of India, were also read out by the Senior Executives and Shri U. Dinesh Shanbhag, Chief Vigilance Officer, NABARD.
- NABARD, in collaboration with the National Bank Staff College, Lucknow, organized Pan-India Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) featuring virtual sessions focused on key topics such as Conduct Rules, Cyber Security and Hygiene, Systems and Procedures of the Organization, Ethics and Governance, and the Public Interest Disclosure and Protection of Informers (PIDPI), aimed at enhancing awareness and fostering a culture of integrity across the organization.
- A variety of competitions were also conducted across NABARD’s Head Office, Regional Offices (ROs), and Training Establishments (TEs) including slogan writing, extempore elocution, talent hunt, thematic quiz, drawing, etc. encouraging active participation and creative expression around the theme of vigilance.
- To further strengthen awareness on preventive vigilance, NABARD undertook a series of impactful outreach initiatives during Vigilance Awareness Week 2025. These included Gram Sabhas and seminars/workshops conducted in schools and colleges across the country. The activities aimed to foster a culture of integrity, transparency, and ethical conduct among various segments of society, reinforcing the message of vigilance as a collective and share responsibility.
- Extensive use of social media platforms was made to ensure wide visibility of Vigilance Awareness Week 2025 activities.
- During the period (27.10.2025 to 03.11.2025), messages were sent through SMS to all NABARD staff (pan-India) emphasizing the importance of vigilance and integrity in the professional as well as personal sphere.

- Banners and Standees (English and Hindi) were displayed in front of Head Office premises and all the residential quarters located in Mumbai during the entire Vigilance Awareness Week (27.10.2025 to 02.11.2025). During the same week, posters/banners were also displayed in English and the local languages in all our Regional Offices / DDM offices / Training Establishments / Subsidiaries as also the residential quarters located in all states across India.
